

Stage 1 Saloon

Lines you have never said from Tombstone


Wyatt is dealing faro when Curly Bill and Ike Clanton walk up to the table. Curly Bill says, "I heard of you." Ike says, "Look, Mr. Kansas City Law Dog. Law don't go around here." Wyatt says, "I'm retired, don't even carry a gun." Ike says, "That's good Mr. Law Dog, 'cause law don't go around here." Wyatt replies, "I heard you the first time. Winner to the King: 500 dollars." Curly Bill says, "Shut up Ike. I like him."

Round Count: 10R-10P-4+SG

Shooting Order: PP-R-SG

Staging: 2P 5 round each holstered; R 10 rounds on center table; SG open and empty in the right window.

Shooter starts on left deck, hands on pistols. Indicate ready by saying the line, "Law don't go around here." At the beep, place 3 rounds on pistol targets any order. With 10th round, engage the knock down target. Move to table and activate the swinger. Place 10 rounds on the 2 round targets any order. Each round target must be engaged at least once. Hitting the swinger is a miss; missing the round targets is a miss. Move to right deck shoot SG targets any order.



Stage 2 Well


Josephine Marcus steps off the stage coach on Main Street in Tombstone. She sees two well dressed men looking at her. She asks fellow actor Mr. Fabian, "Who's that tall drink of water?" Mr. Fabian says, "Note the lean silhouette, eyes closed by the sun yet sharp as a hawk. He has the look of both predator and prey." Josephine : "I want one." Fabian says, "Happy hunting."

Round Count: 10R-10P-4+SG

Shooting Order: R-PP-SG

Staging: Rifle 10 rounds in both hands; 2P 5 rounds each holstered; SG on horse.

Shooter starts one foot touching starting stone; rifle in both hands. Indicate ready by saying the line, "Happy Hunting." At the beep, shoot a progressive sweep on the 2 PR targets: 1on1- 2on2-3on1-4on2 from either direction. Move to table; place open empty rifle on table. Repeat rifle instructions with pistols. Move to horse; shoot SG targets any order.



Stage 3 Fort


U.S. Marshal Crawley Dake offers Wyatt a position as U.S. Deputy Marshal. Wyatt turns him down and says, "That's final." Dake says, "OK. You are here to make some money. That's good but I never met a rich man that didn't have a guilty conscience." Wyatt says, "I already got a guilty conscience. I might as well have the money."

Round Count: 10R-10P-6+SG

Shooting Order: R-SG-PP-SG

Staging: Rifle 10 rounds in both hands; 2P 5 each holstered; SG open empty on barrel.

Shooter starts at the barrel rifle in both hands, Indicate ready by saying the line, "I might as well have the money." At the beep, starting on PR3, shoot a 2-1-2 sweep from either direction, then repeat in the other direction starting on PR3. Place open empty rifle on barrel safely pointed at the berm. With shotgun, shoot SG 1-2-3-4 anywhere between barrel and horse; place open empty SG on horse. Repeat rifle instructions with pistols. Retrieve SG from horse then shoot SG 5-6.



Stage 4 Jail


Wyatt and Josephine meet while on an afternoon ride. While talking, Josephine asks Wyatt what he wants out of life. He replies, "I don't know, make some money, have some children. Josephine says, "Doesn't suit you." Wyatt says, "I ought to know my own mind. I'm telling you what suits me is a family and kids. That suits me right down to the ground. That's my idea of Heaven. What's your idea of heaven?" Josephine says, "Room service."

Round Count: 10R-10P-4+SG

Shooting Order: PP-R-SG

Staging: R10 rounds in window or rack; 2P 5 each holstered; SG open empty on target box.

Shooter starts at window hands flat on window shelf. Indicate ready by saying the line, "Room Service." At the beep, with pistols, shoot a progressive vigilante sweep from either direction: 12-123-1234, then place the 10th round on the cowboy. Take rifle to doorway; repeat pistol instructions with rifle. Place open empty rifle on target box; shoot SG targets any order.



Stage 5 Boot Hill


Doc is playing the piano when Billy Clanton walks over and asks, "Is that Old Dog Trey? That sounds like Old Dog Trey to me." Doc says, "Pardon?" Billy says, "You know, Steven Foster; Old Susana, Camp Town Races; Stephen stinking Foster." Doc says, "This happens to be a Nocturne. You know, Fredrick flippin' Chopin."

Round Count: 10R-10P-4+SG

Shooting Order: PP-R-SG

Staging: 2P 5each holstered; R10 rounds on center table; SG open empty on right table.

Shooter starts on left side of gate hands on pistols. Indicate ready by saying the line, "You know, Stephen stinking Foster." At the beep, shoot a vertical 1-3-1 sweep on the coffin tree starting on either bottom target, then repeat on the other side. Move to gateway; repeat pistol instruction on rifle tree. Place open empty rifle on table; move to right table. Shoot knock downs and the flying clays; a miss on the flying clays can be made up on the stationary clays.



Stage 6 Livery

After the shoot out at Mineral Springs, Doc's health takes a turn for the worse. Turkey Creek asks Doc, "Why are you doing this?" Doc says, "Because Wyatt is my friend." Turkey Creek says, "Hell, I got lots of friends." Doc says, "I don't."

Round Count: 10P-10R-4+SG

Shooting Order: PP-R-SG

Staging: 2P 5 rounds each holstered; Rifle 10 rounds on center table; SG open empty on center table.

Shooter starts at left window hands on window frame. Indicate ready by saying the line, "I got lots of friends." At the beep, with pistols, shoot a continuous clockwise rotation starting at the 12 o'clock position. Move to table; repeat pistol instructions on rifle targets. Place open empty rifle on table; with SG shoot SG 1 and 2 from the table. Move to right window and shoot SG3 and 4.
