Lonesome Dove



Round Count: 10R-10P-4+SG

Shooting Order: Shooter Choice SG last

Staging 2P-5 each holstered R 10 rounds on center table SG on center table.

Shooter starts at the center table hands on pistols or rifle in both hands. Indicate ready by saying the line, **I'd like a chance to shoot an educated man.**" ATB with pistols and rifle as needed sweep the targets with a 1,2,3,4,4,3,2,1, sweep from either direction. With SG engage SG 1 and 2 from the center table move to right deck engage SG 3 and SG4 targets can be shot from either direction.

Blazing Saddles



Round Count 10P-10R-6+SG

Shooting Order PP-R-SG

Staging 2P-5 each R10 rounds SG open empty, all guns on the table.

Shooter starts hands flat on table indicate ready by saying the line, "Dang. That was lucky." ATB sweep pistol targets 3-2-2-3 from either direction. Repeat pistol instructions with rifle. Then engage SG targets any order.



Stage 3 Fort

Blazing Saddles


Sheriff Bart says, "Just give me twenty-four hours to come up with a brilliant idea to save our town. Just twenty-four hours, that's all I ask." The town's people reply, "No." Bart says, "You'd do it for Randolph Scott."

Round Count 10P-10R-4+SG

Shooting Order SG-R-PP

Staging 2P-5 each holstered R10 on barrel SG in both hands at left window.

Shooter starts at the left window SG in both hands. Indicate ready by saying the line, "You'd do it for Randolph Scott." ATB engage SG targets any order make SG safe on the barrel. With rifle engage the cowboy with the first round then Nevada sweep the 5 targets from either direction. Make rifle safe on barrel or the down range table. Move to the table repeat rifle instructions with pistols.



Stage 4 Jail

The Good, the Bad, the Ugly

Blonde is in his hotel room cleaning his pistol when he hears someone's spurs jingle as they come up the stairs. He gets his pistol back together just as the men burst through the door. After the gun fight, Tuco at the window has his gun on him and says, "There's two kinds of spurs, my friend. Those that come in by the door, and those that come in by the window."


Round Count 10P-10R-4+SG

Shooting Order R-PP-SG


Staging R10 rounds in both hands at left table, 2P-5each holstered SG on right table.

Shooter starts at left table rifle in both hands. Indicate ready by saying the line, "There's two kinds of spurs, my friend". ATB engage rifle tree with 2 rounds on each target any order make rifle safe. Repeat rifle instructions with pistols on the pistol tree. Move to right table, engage SG targets any order.

The Good, the Bad, and the Ugly



Round Count 10P-10R-4+SG

Shooting Order PP-R-SG

Staging 2P-5 each holstered R-10 rounds on left table SG on right table.

Shooter starts one foot touching starting stone, hands on pistols. Indicate ready by saying the line, "You Dig". ATB engage KD targets any order till down. Place remaining rounds on stationary target. Move to right table clear the Texas star place remaining rounds on stationary target. Make rifle safe on either table move to right table engage SG targets any order. KD's left standing and plates left on star can be made up with the SG on the stationary target behind SG, KD targets.



Stage 6 Livery

Tombstone

U.S. Marshal Crawley Dake offers Wyatt a position as U.S. Deputy Marshal. Wyatt turns him down and says, "That's final." Dake says, "OK. You are here to make some money. That's good but I never met a rich man that didn't have a guilty conscience." Wyatt says, "I already got a guilty conscience. I might as well have the money."

Round Count 10P-10R-4+SG

Shooting Order R-SG-PP

Staging 2P-5 each holstered R-10 rounds in both hands SG on table.

Shooter starts at the left window rifle in both hands. Indicate ready by saying the line, "Might as well have the money." ATB engage R2 twice then sweep the targets then repeat. Sweep can be from either direction either time. EX; 2- 2-1-2-3 then repeat. Make rifle safe in window or center table move to table engage SG targets any order. Make SG safe on table or right window, move to the right window repeat rifle instructions with pistols.
