## Saloon

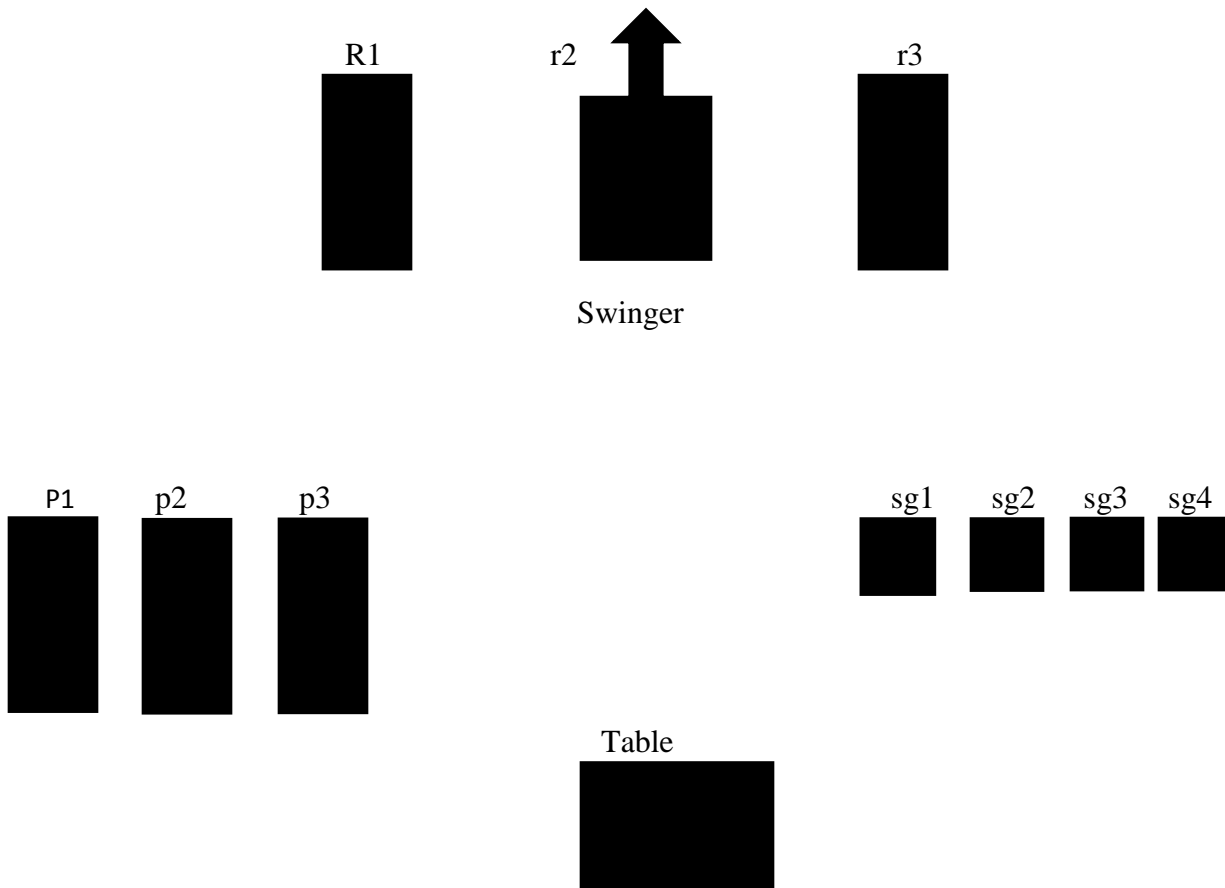

They take him to Professor Wickwire. The professor tells them the Schwinn sisters speak German. They are doing their blacksmithing routine at the saloon to night. After seeing the sisters on stage, Bowler tells Brisco, "I never knew blacksmithing could be so entertaining."

Round Count: 10-10-4+

Shooting Order: PP-R-SG

Staging: 2 Pistol 5 each holstered. Rifle 10 rounds on center table. Shotgun on right table.

Procedure: Shooter starts at left window hands on pistols. When ready say the line, "I never knew blacksmithing could be so entertaining." At the beep, shoot P2 four times then an outside target one time. Then with second pistol shoot P2 four times the other outside target once. Activate swinger and move to table; shoot rifle same as pistols. Make rifle safe and move to right window. Shoot shotgun targets any order.



## Well

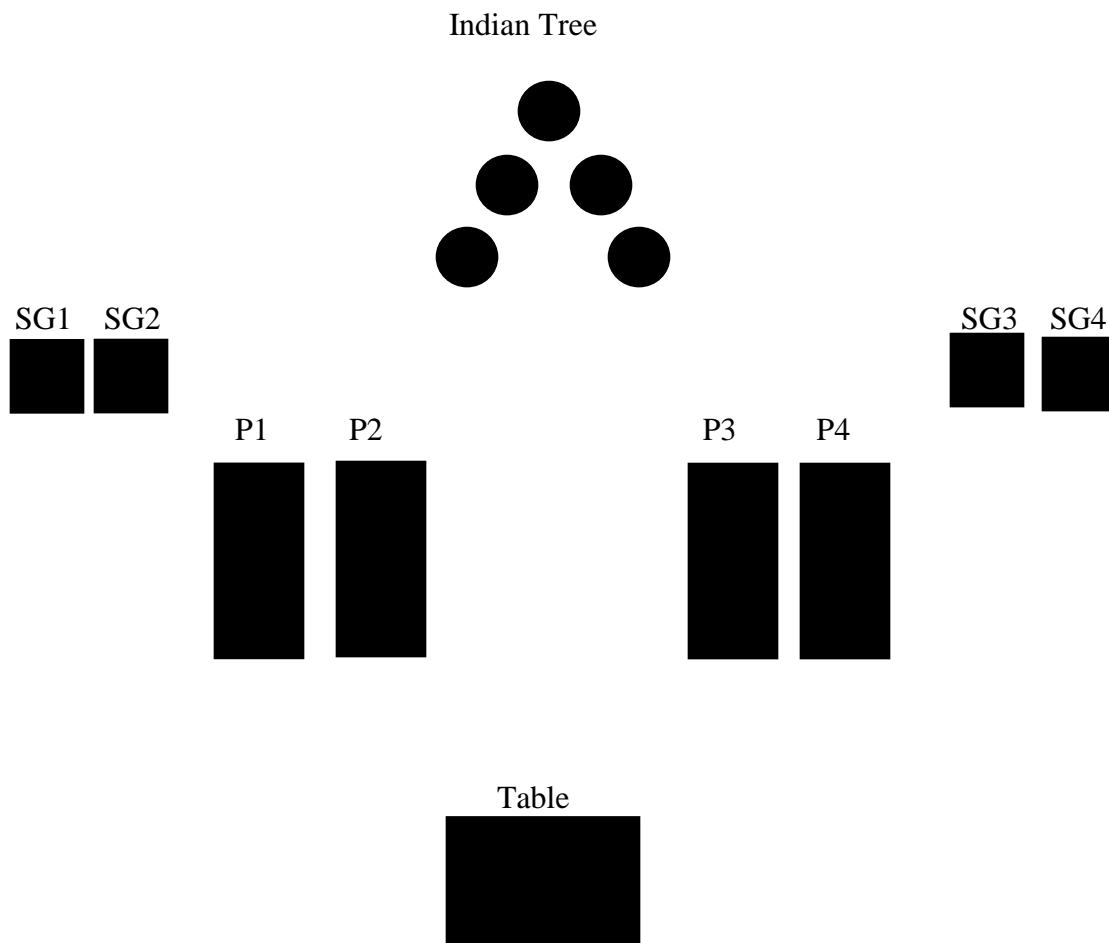
Brisco and Bowler spot a runaway wagon. After stopping the wagon they start to introduce themselves, and one of the young ladies in the wagon says, "You are the men in my dime novel. You are Brisco County Jr. You are his faithful companion Lord Bowler." A very upset Bowler replies, "I'm nobody's faithful companion."

Round count: 10-10-4+

Shooting Order: SG-R-PP-SG

Staging: Shotgun in both hands. 2 Pistol 5 each holstered. Rifle 10 rounds on table.

Shooter starts one foot touching stone, shotgun in both hands. When ready say the line, "I'm nobody's faithful companion." At the beep, shoot the 2 shotgun targets, then move to table. With rifle shoot 2 vertical Nevada sweeps starting on either bottom targets. Repeat on other side. Place open empty rifle on table. With pistol alternate 5 rounds on P1 and P2. With second pistol alternate 5 rounds on P3 and P4. Take shotgun to right of table shoot last 2 shotgun targets.



Fort

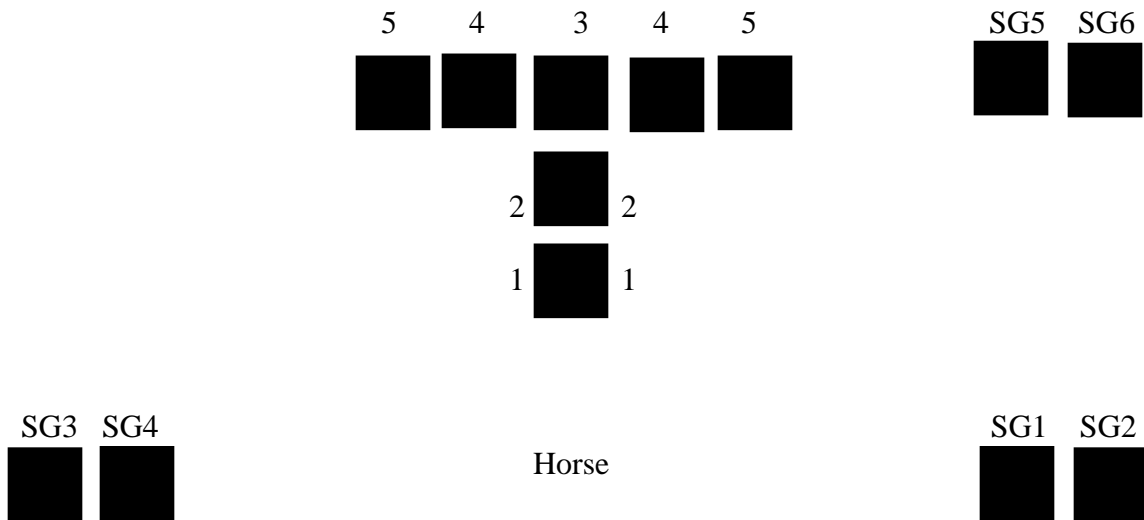
Brisco and Bowler track a group of young guns to an abandoned fort. After a brief gun battle, the young men escape. Brisco asks Bowler, "Is it me, or is that the best looking gang you've ever seen?" Bowler replies, "Brisco this business is getting to dang glamorous."

Round count: 10-10-6+

Shooting order: R-SG-PP

Staging: 2 pistols 5 each holstered. Rifle in both hands. Shotgun on barrel.

Shooter starts one foot touching stone with rifle in both hands. When ready say the line, "This business is getting to dang glamorous." At the beep, shoot rifle targets 1-2-3-4-5 repeat 1-2-3 then 4-5 on the other side. Place open empty rifle on barrel, and with shotgun shoot shotgun targets anywhere from stone to the horse. Place open empty shotgun on horse. With pistols shoot targets same as rifle.

## Jail

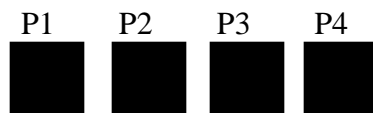
After Brisco introduces Professor Ogden Cole to Lord Bowler, the professor says, "A completely fictitious title I presume." Lord Bowler replies, "No it ain't. I just made it up."

Round count: 10-10-4+

Shooting order: R-PP-SG

Staging 2 pistols 5 each rifle 10 rounds on target box shotgun open empty in window

Shooter starts in jail cell door open hands on door frame. When ready say the line, "No it ain't, I just made it up." At the beep move to target box and shoot rifle targets with a cat headers sweep which is the same as a Nevada sweep but double tap the end targets. Place open empty rifle on target box. Shoot pistol targets same as rifle. Move to window and shoot shotgun targets any order.



## Cemetery

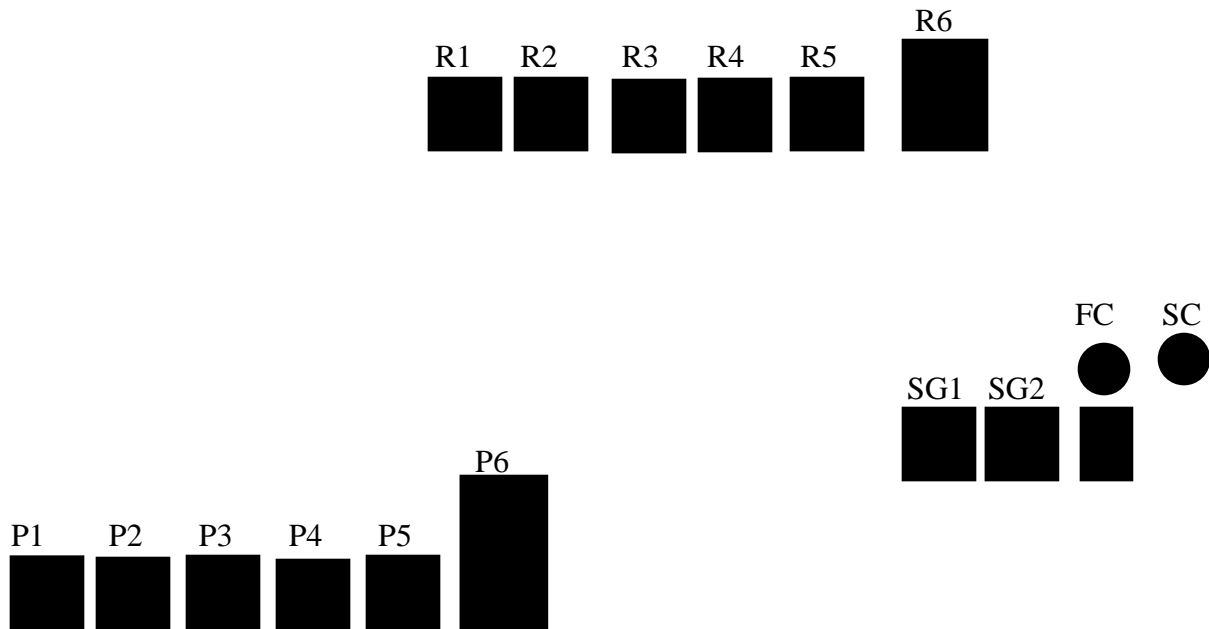
Bowler tells Brisco, "When you get our next assignment you can find me at this address." When Brisco travels to the address he cannot believe what he sees; it's the biggest mansion on Knob Hill. When he rings the doorbell an English butler answers the door. When Brisco introduces himself, the butler replies, "You must be his Lordship's faithful companion."

Round Count: 10-10-4+

Shooting order: PP-R-SG

Staging: 2 pistol 5 each holstered. Rifle 10 rounds on table. Shotgun open empty on right table.

Shooter starts on left side of gate hands with on pistols. When ready say the line, "You must be his Lordship's faithful companion." At the beep, shoot the 5 knock down targets and then place remaining rounds on stationary target. Move to center table and repeat with rifle. Make rifle safe and move to right table. Shoot shotgun targets any order. A miss on flying clay may be made up on stationary clay. If any knock down targets were left up, shooter can shoot them with shotgun.



## Livery

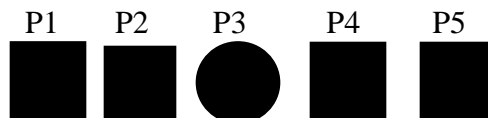
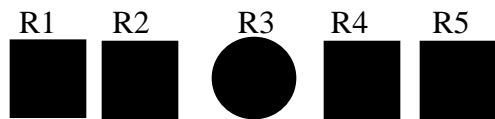
Brisco and Bowler are on the trail of Big Smith and his gang. Bowler dismounts to read trail signs. He tells Brisco four out riders are escorting an armored wagon. The wagon is being pulled by four young horses and one has a loose shoe. Big Smith with five of his men are about two hours behind. Brisco says, "You can't tell all that from those tracks." Bowler says, "I can tell more, but that's all you need to know." Brisco says, "Go on; tell me." Bowler says, "A 700 pound grizzly crossed the road this morning and she is about to have twins. What can I say? Dirt just talks to me."

Round Count: 10-10-4+

Shooting Order: PP-R-SG

Staging 2pistol 5 each holstered rifle 10 rounds in left window shotgun open empty in right window

Shooter Starts behind center table hands on pistols. When ready say the line, "Dirt just talks to me." At the beep, shoot 2 Nevada sweeps starting on P3. 3-2-1-2-3 then 3-4-5-4-3. Move to left window. Repeat with rifle. Make rifle safe. Move to right window and shoot shotgun targets any order.

## Warmup

Round Count: 10-10-4+

Shooting Order: R-PP-SG

Staging: Rifle in both hands at left window. 2 pistol holstered. Shotgun open empty right window.

Shooter starts at left window rifle in both hands. When ready, say the line, "Ready." At the beep, sweep rifle targets twice either direction. Move to table and repeat with pistols. Move to right window and shoot shotgun targets any order.
