

## Stage 1 - Saloon

Briscoe is in Old Mexico playing cards with General Mapache, the crookedest General in Mexico. During the game, the General tells one of the women, "Margaretta, bring us one of those wonderful drinks you make with tequila and lime."


Round Count: 10 R-10 P-6+ SG

Shooting Order: R-SG-PP

Staging: 2P- 5 rounds each holstered; R-10 rounds in left window; SG on center table.

Shooter starts at left window hands flat on shelf. Indicate ready by saying the line, "**Margaretta, bring us one of those wonderful drinks you make.**" ATB, engage R2 1 time, then R1 and 3 -2 times any order, then repeat; ex 1-2-2 then repeat. Make rifle safe in window or table. Move to the table; engage SG targets any order. Make SG safe on table or right window. Move to right window; repeat rifle instructions with pistols.


### Rifle Targets

## Stage 2 - Well

Briscoe County Jr.


Briscoe has an interview with the west coast millionaires for the job as trouble shooter. During the interview, Comet walks into the board room. Briscoe says, "Hey we have had this conversation before. You are supposed to stay at the hitching post." Then tells the millionaires, "You will have to excuse Comet; he doesn't know he is a horse."

Round Count: 10P-10R-4+SG

Shooting Order: R-SG-PP

Staging: 2P-5 each holstered; SG on barrel; R-10 rounds in both hands.

Shooter starts at the barrel rifle in both hands. Indicate ready by saying the line, "**He doesn't know he is a horse.**" ATB, with rifle, alternate 5 rounds on the center and end target any order, then repeat between the center and other end target any order. Make rifle safe on barrel. Engage SG targets any order between barrel and table. Make SG safe on table. Repeat rifle instructions with pistols.



Stage 3 - Fort

Briscoe County Jr.


Briscoe, working undercover, joins Big Smith's Gang. He introduces himself as the outlaw Kansas Willey Stanford. One of the gang members asks, "Where you from Kansas?"

Round Count: 10R-10P-4+SG

Shooting Order: SG-R-PP

Staging: 2P-5 each holstered; R-10 rounds on barrel; SG in both hands.

Shooter starts at the left window SG in both hands. Indicate ready by saying the line, "**Where you from Kansas?**" ATB, engage SG targets any order. Move to the barrel; make SG safe on barrel. With rifle, engage rifle targets with a double tap 1-5-2-4-3 sweep. Ex: outside, outside, inside, inside, center. Sweep can be from either direction. Make rifle safe on barrel or down range table. Move to the table; repeat rifle instructions with pistols.



## Stage 4 - Jail


Big Smith tells his girlfriend Dixie, "That's not Kansas Willey Stanford; take him upstairs and find out who he is." When they get to her room, Briscoe is staring at her bed. She asks him, "Do you like the bed? It's French." Briscoe says, "Louie the Fourteenth." Dixie replies, "No, I think Louie was the eighth or ninth."

Round Count: 10R-10P-4+SG

Shooting Order: PP-R-SG

Staging: 2P-5 each holstered; R-10 rounds on target box; SG open empty in right window.

Shooter starts at target box hands on pistols. Indicate ready by saying the line, "**It's French.**" At the beep, engage the round target 3 times, then one of the square targets 2 times, then the round target 3 times, and the other square target 2 times. EX: 3-2-3-2. Repeat pistol instructions with rifle: 3-2-3-2. Make rifle safe on box or right window or rack. Move to right window; shoot SG targets any order.



## Stage 5 - Boot Hill


Briscoe see's Pete Hutter and asks, "Correct me if I'm wrong, Pete. Weren't you killed in a gunfight?" Pete replies, "I was only gut shot. I healed, I'm stronger now just with less appetite."

Round Count: 10P-10R-4+SG

Shooting Order: PP-R-SG

Staging: 2 P-5 each holstered; R-10 rounds on left table; SG on right table.

Shooter starts one-foot touching stone hands on hat brim. Indicate ready by saying the line, "**I was only gut shot.**" ATB, triple tap the pistol targets any order; place the 10<sup>th</sup> round on the KD target. Move to left table; repeat pistol instructions with rifle. Make rifle safe on either table. Move to right table; engage SG targets any order. Misses on the pistol/rifle KD or clay bird can be made up on the cowboy.



## Stage 6 - Livery

Briscoe County Jr.

Briscoe and Bowler become deputy's to help an old friend clean up the town. One morning, Bowler is making the early morning rounds when he sees a young boy walking down the street. Bowler says, "You're up early." The boy replies, "I get up early every morning." Bowler asks, "What you got in the bag?" He replies, "Doughnuts. Here's have one." Then says, "I have to go now." Bowler ask, "What's your name?" He replies, "Duncan." Bowler tells him, "You make good dougnuts Duncan."

Round Count: 10P-10R-4+SG

Shooting Order: R-SG-PP

Staging: 2P-5 each holstered; R-10 in both hands at left window; SG on mule.

Shooter starts at left window Rifle in both hands. Indicate ready by saying the line, "**You make good donuts Duncan.**" ATB, engage rifle targets with a double tap Nevada Sweep starting on R2. Take rifle to mule; make rifle safe on the mule. Engage SG targets anywhere between the mule and down range table. Make SG safe on table; repeat rifle instructions with pistols.
