

## Stage 1 - Saloon

### El Dorado

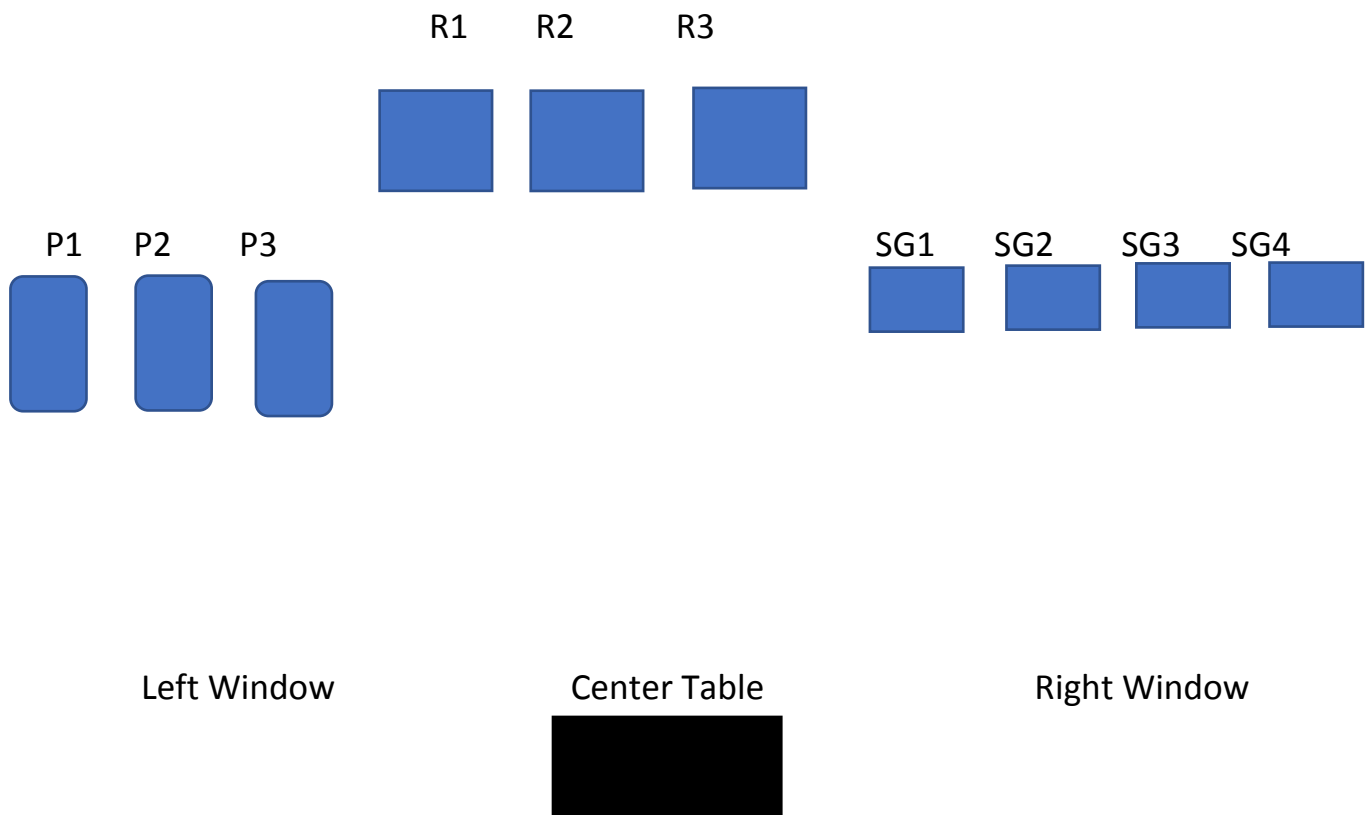
Bart Jason has hired a gunfighter to take care of Sheriff JP Harrah. When Cole Thornton rides into town, JP finds him in the saloon wash room. JP says, "I understand you're working for Bart Jason." Cole replies, "Nothing is set yet. He's offered me good money." JP tells Cole, "The job is taking care of me." Cole moves closer to where his gun is hanging. JP says, "That's close enough to your gun." Cole replies, "I was just seeing if you had slowed down any." JP, "Not that much."

Round Count: 10R-10P-4+SG

Shooting Order: PP-R-SG

Staging: 2P-5 rounds each holstered; R10-rounds on center table; SG in right window.

Shooter starts at left window, hands on pistols. Indicate ready by saying the line, "**Not that much.**" ATB, sweep the pistol targets 3-4-3 from either direction. Move to center table, repeat pistol instructions with rifle. Make rifle safe on table or right window. Move to right window, engage SG targets any order.



## Stage 2 - Well

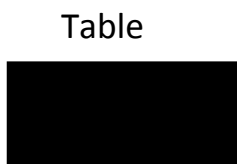
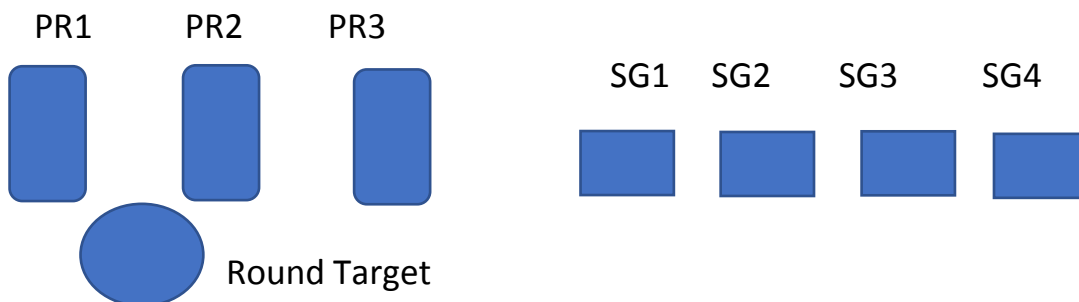
After Mississippi knifes one of Nelse Mcleod's men, one of the others, Milt, draws. Cole shoots the gun from his hand, then says, "Pick it up." Mcleod says, "Hold it, I just lost one man, I can't afford to lose another." Milt says, "You have a lot of faith in me." Mcleod replies, "Faith can move a mountain, but it can't beat a faster draw. There's only 3 men with a draw that fast, one's dead, one's me, the other is Cole Thornton." Cole says, "There's a fourth." Mcleod asks, "Which one are you?" Cole replies, "I'm Thornton."

Round Count 10P-10R-4+SG

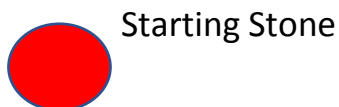
Shooting Order R-PP-SG

Staging 2P-5 each holstered; R10-rounds in both hands; SG on the horse.

Shooter starts one foot touching starting stone. Indicate ready by saying the line, **There's a Fourth**. ATB engage rifle targets with an alternating double tap sweep. Sweep can be from either direction. EX: double tap PR1, double tap round target, double tap PR2, double tap round target, double tap PR3. Make rifle safe on table, repeat rifle instructions with pistols. Move to the horse, engage SG targets any order.

## Stage 3 Fort

### El Dorado

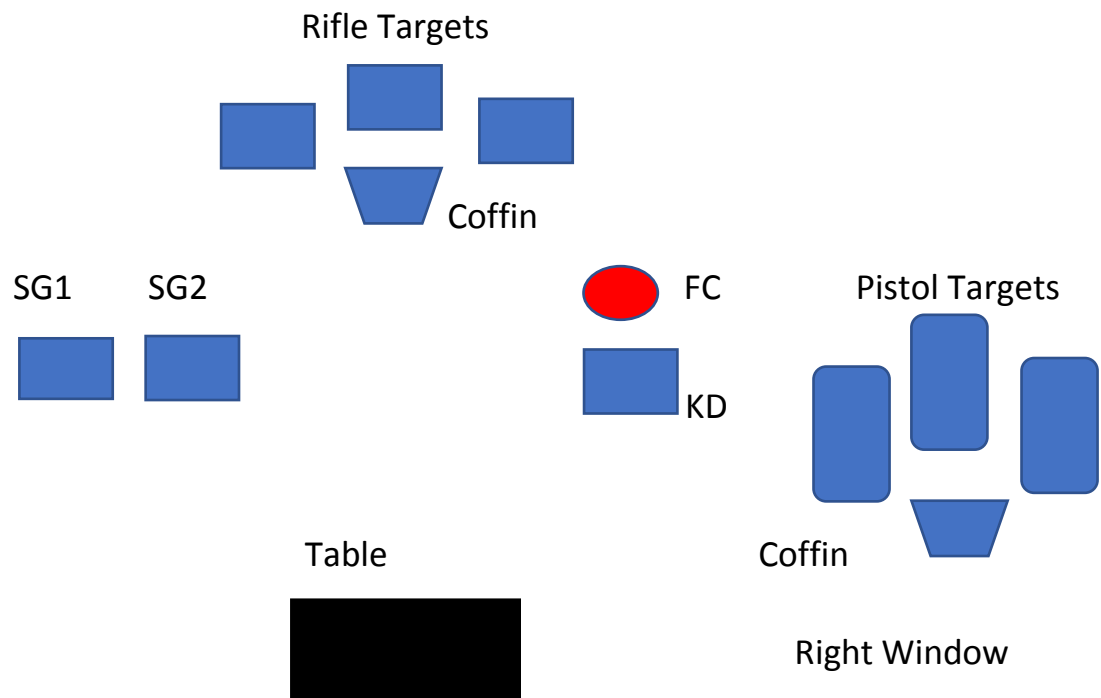
After the fracas with Mcleod's men, Mississippi is in a hurry to leave the saloon. Cole keeps telling him to hold up as he talks to Mcleod. Cole ask Mcleod if he would like to walk out the door in front of them. Mcleod says, "No I would not," then walks over and says, "Milt, Pedro, I'm coming out. Come into the light and drop your guns." Cole says, "Thanks Mcleod." Mcleod replies, "Call it professional courtsey."

Round Count 10R-10P-4+SG

Shooting Order SG-R-PP

Staging 2P-5 each holstered; R10 rounds on table; SG on table.

Shooter starts at the table, both hands on SG shells. Indicate ready by saying the line, **Call it professional courtsey**. ATB engage SG targets any order. A miss on the flying clay can be made up on the rifle coffin target with SG. With rifle, tripple tap the square targets any order, then place the 10th round on the coffin target. Make rifle safe on the table or right window. Move to the right window, repeat rifle instructions with pistols.



## Stage 4 Jail

### EL Dorado

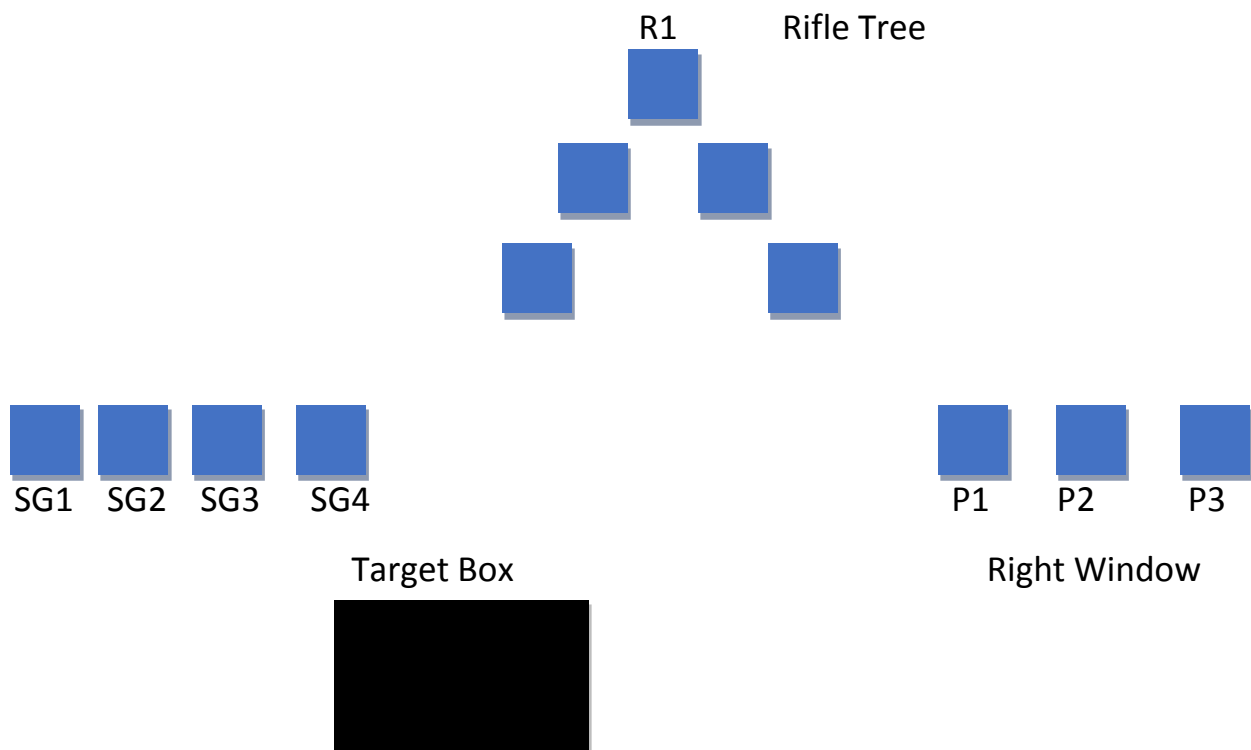
Mcleod tells Cole he is on his way to El Dorado to work for Bart Jason in a range war. The only opposition is a drunk sheriff. Cole's plan is to beat Mcleod to El Dorado so he can sober up JP. On the way he sees someone following him. When the man gets closer, he sees it's Mississippi. Cole yells, "Don't you know better than to follow a man that way?" Mississippi says, "Sorry I didn't know there was another way."

Round Count 10R-10P-4+SG

Shooting Order PP-R-SG

Staging 2P-5 each holstered; R10 rounds on target box; SG on target box.

Shooter starts at right window, hands on window frame. Indicate ready by saying the line, **I didn't know there was another way**. ATB with pistols, shoot 2 vigilante sweeps either direction either time, which is 12-123 then repeat. Move to target box. With rifle, shoot 2 vertical vigilante sweeps starting on R1, which is the top target, then repeat on the other side. Place open empty rifle on target box. With SG, shoot SG targets any order.



# Stage 5 Boot Hill

## El Dorado

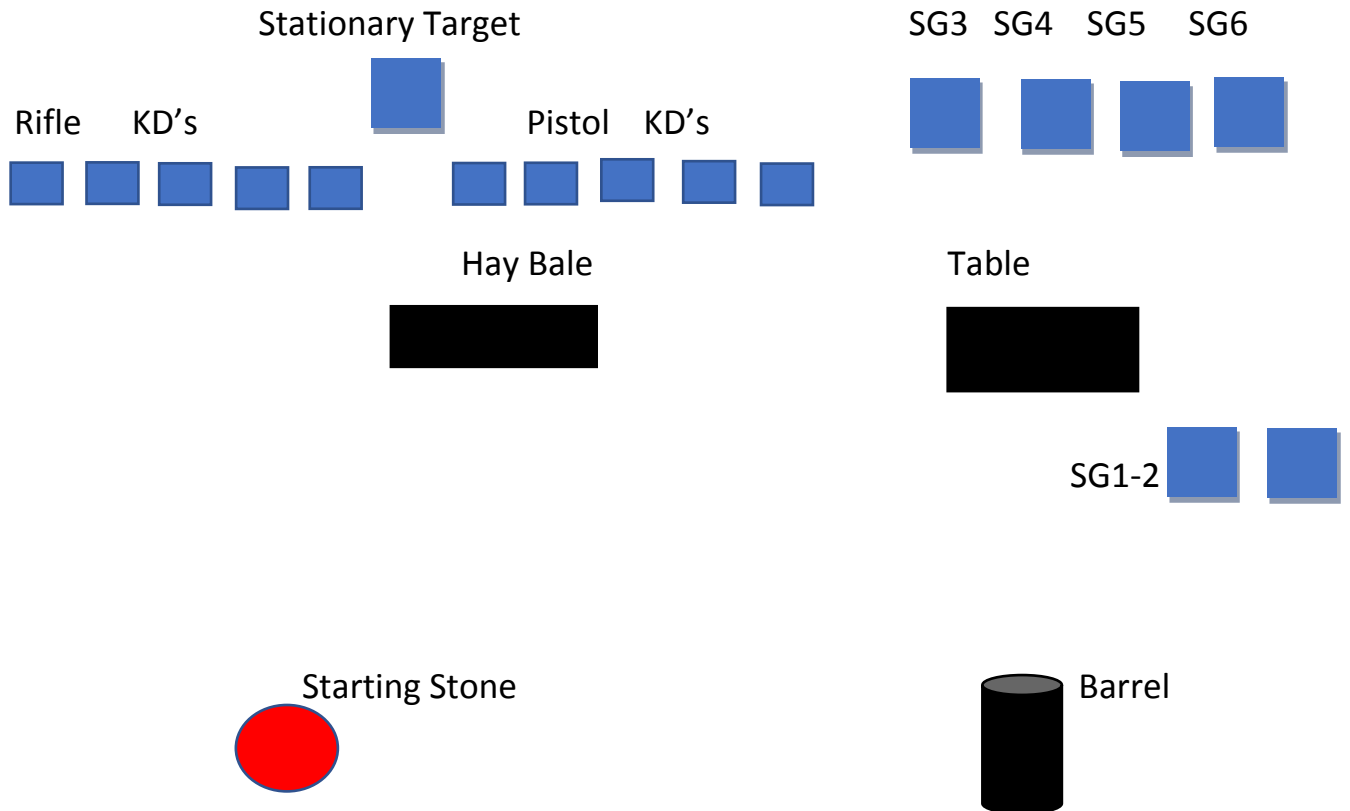
Cole and Mississippi get into town about midnight. As they ride up to the jail, Bull yells out, "Stop right there, that's close enough." Cole yells back, "Don't shoot, it's me, Cole Thornton." Bull tells Cole, "I would have recognized you right off, but I was trying to figure out what that other fellow has on his head." Mississippi says, "It's called a hat." Bull replies, "I'll have to take your word for that."

Round Count 10P-10R-6+SG

Shooting Order R-SG-PP

Staging 2P-5each holstered; SG on barrel; R10 rounds in both hands.

Shooter starts one foot touching starting stone, rifle in both hands. Indicate ready by saying the line, **It's called a hat.** ATB engage the 5-KD targets on the left, any order. Place remaining rounds on the stationary target. Make rifle safe on the barrel. With SG, engage SG 1 and 2 any order. Move to table engage SG 3-4-5-6 any order. Make SG safe on table. Move to hay bale. Engage the 5-KD targets on the right, any order. Place remaining rounds on stationary target.



## Stage 6 Livery

### El Dorado

After JP is shot in the leg during the shoot-out with Jason's men, he decides to fort up in the jail till the U.S. Marshal comes for Joe. Bull tells JP, "It would be a lot nicer in here if a certain fellow I know would take a bath." JP replies, "I guess I do need to clean up a little." The next morning as he takes a bath, Joey McDonald walks in and tells JP, "The Doc sent over some clean cloths and a bar of soap. I brought one too." JP holds up 2 bars of soap then says, "I've got lots of friends, Joey."

Round Count 10R-10P-4+SG

Shooting Order PP-R-SG

Staging 2P-5 each holstered; R10 in left window; SG on center table.

Shooter starts at center table, hands on pistols. Indicate ready by saying the line, **I've got lots of friends**. ATB engage targets with a continuous 10 round Nevada sweep, double tapping P2 each time. Sweep can be from either direction. EX: 1-22-3-22-1-22-3. Move to left window, repeat pistol instructions with rifle. Make rifle safe in window or table. Move to table. With SG engage SG 1 and 2 any order. Move to right window. Engage SG 3 and 4 any order.
