

## Stage 1 Saloon

### Tombstone


Wyatt is dealing faro when Curly Bill and Ike Clanton walk up to the table. Curly Bill says, "I heard of you." Ike says, "Look, Mr. Kansas City Law Dog. Law don't go around here." Wyatt says, "I'm retired, don't even carry a gun." Ike says, "That's good Mr. Law Dog, 'cause law don't go around here." Wyatt replies, "I heard you the first time. Winner to the King: 500 dollars." Curly Bill says, "Shut up Ike. I like him."

Round count 10 R-10 P-4+SG

Shooting Order PP-R-SG

Staging 2P- 5 rounds each holstered R-10 rounds in right window SG on table on right deck.

Shooter starts outside the saloon hands on closed doors. Indicate ready by saying the line, "Shut up Ike". ATB move to left window engage pistol targets in a double tap Nevada sweep starting on P2. Sweep can be in either direction. Move to right window repeat pistol instructions with rifle. Make rifle safe in window or right table. Move to right table engage SG targets any order.



## Stage 2 Well


Josephine Marcus steps off the stage coach on Main Street in Tombstone. She sees two well-dressed men looking at her. She asks fellow actor Mr. Fabian, "Who's that tall drink of water?" Mr. Fabian says, "Note the lean silhouette, eyes closed by the sun yet sharp as a hawk. He has the look of both predator and prey." Josephine: "I want one." Fabian says, "Happy hunting."

Round Count 10R-10P-4+SG

Shooting Order R-PP-SG

Staging 2P-5 each holstered R-10 rounds in both hands SG on horse.

Shooter starts one foot touching starting stone rifle in both hands. Indicate ready by saying the line, "Happy Hunting". ATB engage targets with a double tap 1-5-2-4-3 sweep. EX: outside, outside, inside. Inside, center. Sweep can start on either side. Place rifle on down range table. Repeat rifle instructions with pistols. Move to horse engage SG targets any order.



### Stage 3 Fort


U.S. Marshal Crawley Dake offers Wyatt a position as U.S. Deputy Marshal. Wyatt turns him down and says, "That's final." Dake says, "OK. You are here to make some money. That's good but I never met a rich man that didn't have a guilty conscience." Wyatt says, "I already got a guilty conscience. I might as well have the money."

Round Count 10P-10R-4+SG

Shooting Order PP-R-SG

Staging 2P-5 each holstered R 10 rounds on center table SG in Right window.

Shooter starts at the left window hands on pistols. Indicate ready by saying the line, "I already got a guilty conscience". ATB engage pistol target P2 one-time P1 and P3 two times EX 1-2-2. Then repeat, P1 and P3 can be engaged any order either time. Move to center table repeat pistol instructions with rifle. Make rifle safe on table or right window. Move to right window engage SG targets any order.



## Stage 4 Jail


Wyatt and Josephine meet while on an afternoon ride. While talking, Josephine asks Wyatt what he wants out of life. He replies, "I don't know, make some money, have some children. Josephine says, "Doesn't suit you." Wyatt says, "I ought to know my own mind. I'm telling you what suits me is a family and kids. That suits me right down to the ground. That's my idea of Heaven. What's your idea of heaven?" Josephine says, "Room service."

Round Count 10R-10P- 4+SG

Shooting Order R-PP-SG

Staging R-10 rounds in both hands 2P-5 each holstered SG on right table.

Shooter starts one foot touching starting stone rifle in both hands. Indicate ready by saying the line, "Room Service." ATB engage the stationary 3 times then any 2 KD targets then repeat. Place open empty rifle on left down range then repeat rifle instructions with pistols. Move to right table engage SG targets any order. Any pistol or rifle targets left standing can be made up on stationary target behind SG targets.



## Stage 5 Boot Hill


Doc is playing the piano when Billy Clanton walks over and asks, "Is that Old Dog Trey? That sounds like Old Dog Trey to me." Doc says, "Pardon?" Billy says, "You know, Steven Foster; Old Susana, Camp Town Races; Stephen stinking Foster." Doc says, "This happens to be a Nocturne. You know, Fredrick Flippin' Chopin."

Round Count: 10R-10P-8+SG

Shooting Order: R-SG-PP

Staging R10-Rounds in both hands 2P-5 each holstered SG on barrel.

Shooter starts at the barrel rifle in both hands. Indicate ready by saying the line, "You know, Fredrick Flippin' Chopin." ATB alternate 5 rounds on any 2 PR targets then repeat on the other 2. Make rifle safe on the barrel, engage SG targets between the barrel and down range table. Make SG on table repeat rifle instructions with pistols.



## Stage 6 Livery

After the shoot-out at Mineral Springs, Doc's health takes a turn for the worse. Turkey Creek asks Doc, "Why are you doing this?" Doc says, "Because Wyatt is my friend." Turkey Creek says, "Hell, I got lots of friends." Doc says, "I don't."

Round Count: 10P-10R-4+SG

Shooting Order: PP-R-SG

Staging 2P-5 each holstered R-10 rounds on table SG on table.

Shooter starts at table in door way hands on pistols. Indicate ready by saying the line, "Because Wyatt is my friend." ATB engage Pistol targets with a progressive sweep EX: 1 on 1- 2 on 2 -3 on 1- 4 on 2. Repeat pistol instructions with rifle. With SG engage SG 1 and 2 from table move to right window engage SG 3 and 4.
