

Stage 1 Saloon



Round Count: 10P-10R-4+SG

Shooting Order: SG-R-PP

Staging 2P-5 each holstered R10-rounds on center table SG in both hands-on left deck.

Shooter starts on the left deck SG in both hands. Indicate ready by saying, **"Margaretta, bring us one of those wonderful drinks you make."** ATB engage SG 1 and 2 any order move to the center table engage SG 3 and 4. SG 4 is the swinger activator. With rifle place 4 rounds on the swinger, 1 round on either stationary target. Then repeat 4 rounds on the swinger, 1 round on the other stationary target. EX;4-1-4-1. Make rifle safe on the center table or right window. Move to right window engage P2-4 times either outside 1 time then repeat, P2-4 times the other outside target 1 times. EX 4-1-4-1



Stage 2 Well



Round Count: 10R-10P-4+SG

Shooting Order R-SG-PP

Staging 2P-5 each holstered R10 rounds on the barrel SG on the barrel.

Shooter starts at the barrel hands on hat brim. Indicate ready by saying the line, "**Hey, we have had this conversation before.**" ATB Shooters choice 10 on 4 any order. Make rifle safe, with SG engage targets any order make SG safe on the barrel or table. At the table repeat rifle instructions with pistols.

Stage 3 Fort


Briscoe, working undercover, joins Big Smith's Gang. He introduces himself as the outlaw Kansas Willey Stanford. One of the gang members asks, "Where you from Kansas?"

Round Count: 10R-10P-4+SG

Shooting Order: R-SG-PP

Staging: 2P-5 each holstered; R10-in both hands; SG on table no.1.

Shooter starts at the barrel rifle in both hands. Indicate ready by saying the line, "**Where you from Kansas.**" ATB, engage rifle targets with a 1-5-2-4-3 double tap sweep. EX: outside-outside- inside-inside- center. Sweep can be from either direction. Make rifle safe on barrel or table no.1 move to table No. 1; engage SG targets any order. Make SG safe on either table. Move to table No.2; repeat rifle instructions with pistols.



Stage 4 - Jail


Big Smith tells his girlfriend Dixie, "That's not Kansas Willey Stanford; take him upstairs and find out who he is." When they get to her room, Briscoe is staring at her bed. She asks him, "Do you like the bed? It's French." Briscoe says, "Louie the Fourteenth." Dixie replies, "No, I think Louie was the eighth or ninth."

Round Count: 10R-10P-4+SG

Shooting Order: PP-R-SG

Staging: 2P-5 each holstered; R-10 rounds on target box; SG open empty in right window.

Shooter starts at the target box hands on pistols. Indicate ready by saying the line, "**It's French.**" At the beep, engage the pistol targets with a continuous 10 round Nevada sweep double tapping P2 each time. EX: 1-22-3-22-1-22-3. Sweep can be in either direction. Repeat pistol instructions with rifle. Move to SG engage SG targets any order.



Stage 5 - Boot Hill


Briscoe see's Pete Hutter and asks, "Correct me if I'm wrong, Pete. Weren't you killed in a gunfight?" Pete replies, "I was only gut shot. I healed, I'm stronger now just with less appetite."

Round Count: 10P-10R-4+SG

Shooting Order: R-PP-SG

Staging 2P-5 each holstered R10 rounds in both hands SG on the table.

Shooter starts one foot touching starting stone rifle in both hands. Indicate ready by saying the line, "**I was only gut shot**". ATB starting on either outside target, sweep the targets 1-1-3 for 5 rounds then repeat on the other side. Make rifle safe on the table repeat rifle instructions with pistols. Engage SG targets any order.



Stage 6 - Livery

Brisco and Bowler are on the trail of a newly formed outlaw gang. These young men are the best dressed and groomed men anyone has ever seen. Briscoe and Bowler find them at the livery stable. After a brief gun fight the men escape. Briscoe ask Bowler is it just me, or is that the best looking gang you have ever seen? Bowler replies, you know Brisco this business is getting to dang glamorous.

Round Count: 10P-10R-4+SG

Shooting Order: SG-shooter's choice-SG

Staging: 2P-5each holstered; Rifle 10 rounds on center table; SG in both hands at left window.

Shooter starts at the left window SG in both hands. Indicate ready by saying the line, **"This business is getting to dang glamorous."** ATB, engage SG 1 and 2 any order; make SG safe on center table. Shooter's choice next, pistols or rifle, engage the round target 4 times, then each square target 3 times. Same for rifle and pistols EX 4-3-3 then repeat. Take SG to right window; engage SG 3 and 4 any order.
