

Stage 1 Saloon

Lonesome Dove

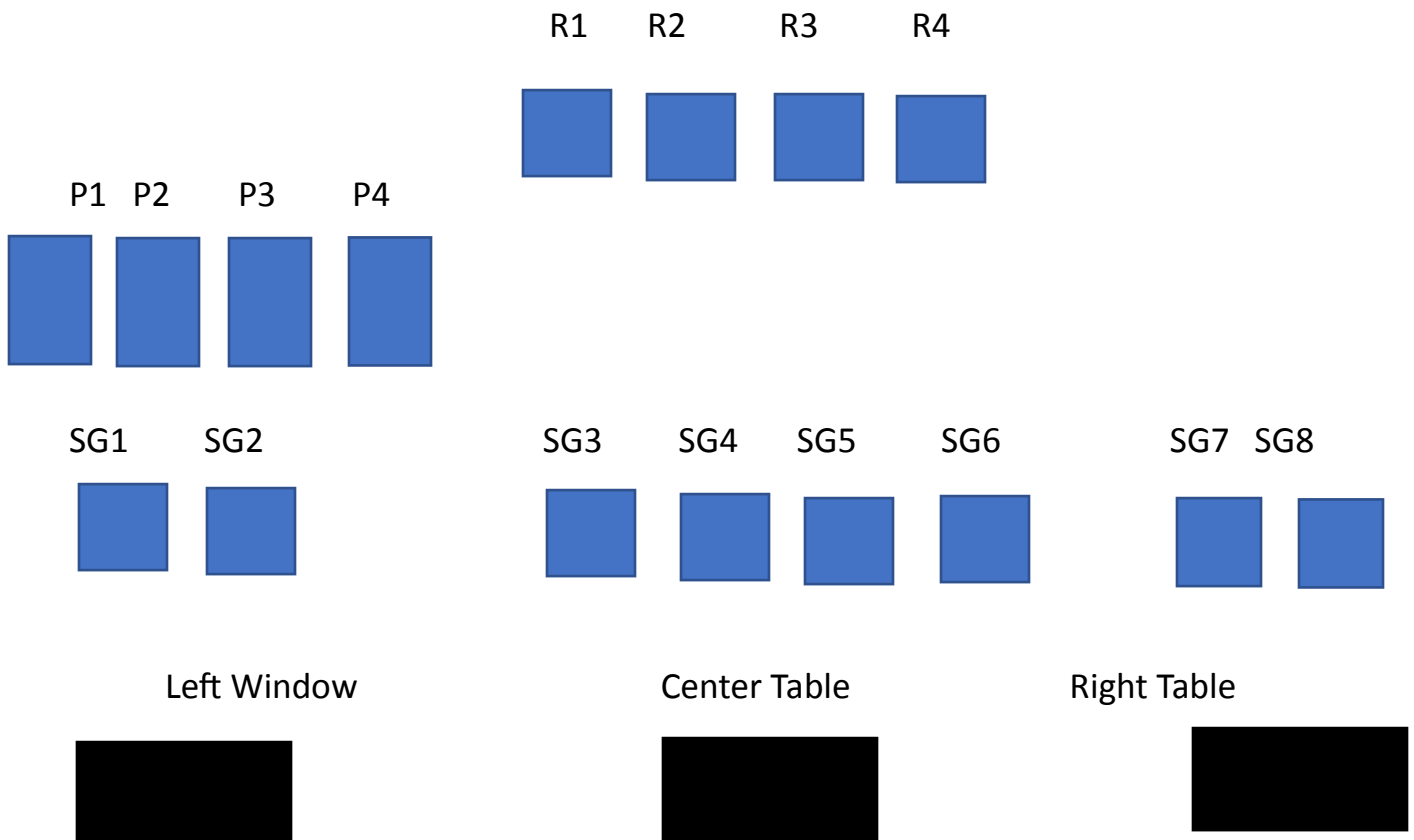
After catching Jake Spoon with a gang of murdering horse thieves. Gus tells Jake, you know how it works. If you ride with outlaws you hang with outlaws.

Round Count: 10R-10P-8+SG

Shooting order: P-SG-R-SG

Staging: 2P- 5 each holstered: R-10 rounds on center table SG in left window.

Shooter starts at the left window hands on pistols. Indicate ready by saying the line, "You know how it works". ATB with pistols alternate 5 rounds between any 2 of the pistol targets. Then 5 rounds between the other 2 targets. Engage SG 1 and 2, move to the center table and engage SG 3-4-5-6. Make SG safe on the table, repeat pistol instructions with rifle. Take SG to right window engage SG 7-8. SG targets can be engaged in any order.



Stage 2 Well

Saloon Blazing Saddles

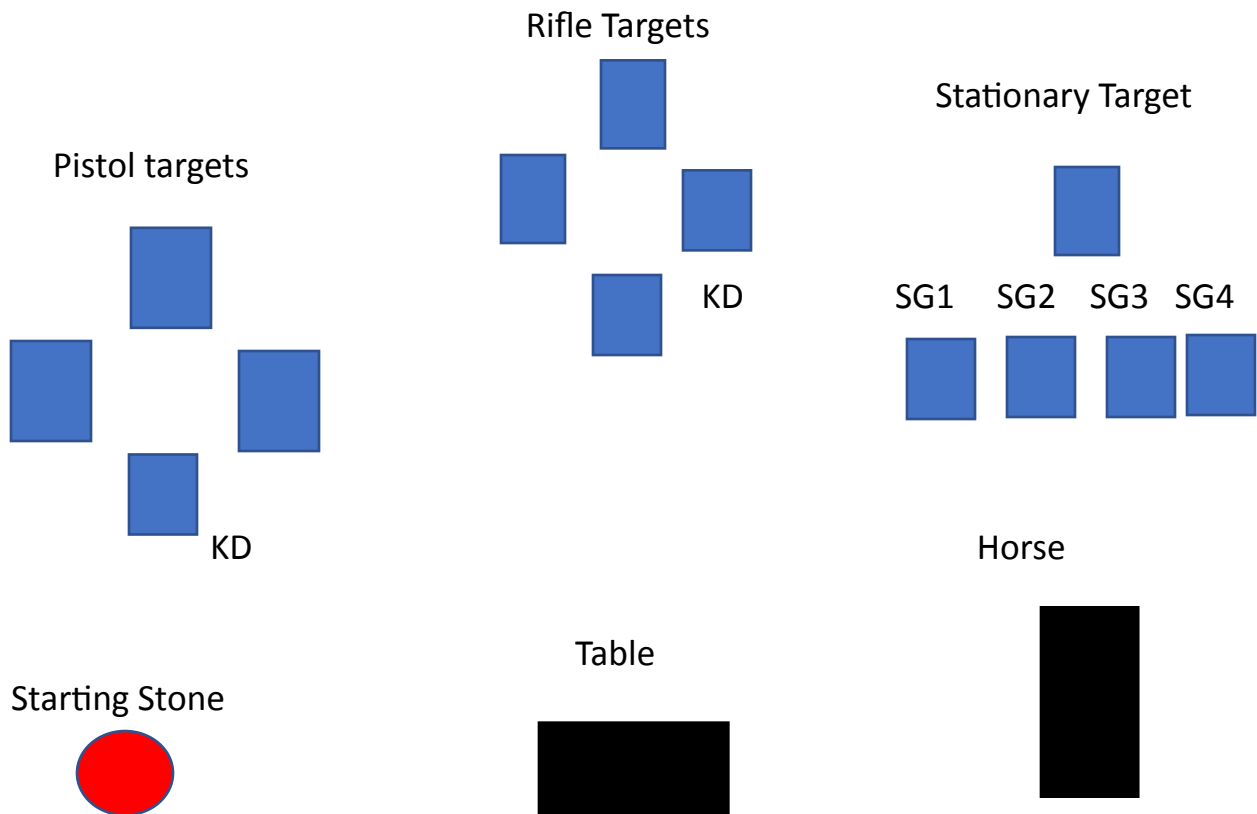
Sheriff Bart says, "Just give me twenty-four hours to come up with a brilliant idea to save our town. Just twenty-four hours, that's all I ask." The town's people reply, "No." Bart says, "You'd do it for Randolph Scott."

Round Count: 10R- 10P- 4+SG

Shooting Order: PP-R-SG

Stagging: 2 P- 5 each holstered R-10 rounds on the left table SG on the horse.

Shooter starts one foot touching starting stone hands on pistols. Indicate ready by saying the line, "You'd do it for Randolph Scott." ATB triple tap the pistol targets any order place the 10th round on the KD target. At the table repeat pistol instructions with rifle. At the horse engage SG targets any order. KD left standing can be made up on the stationary target with shotgun.



Stage 3 Fort

Tombstone

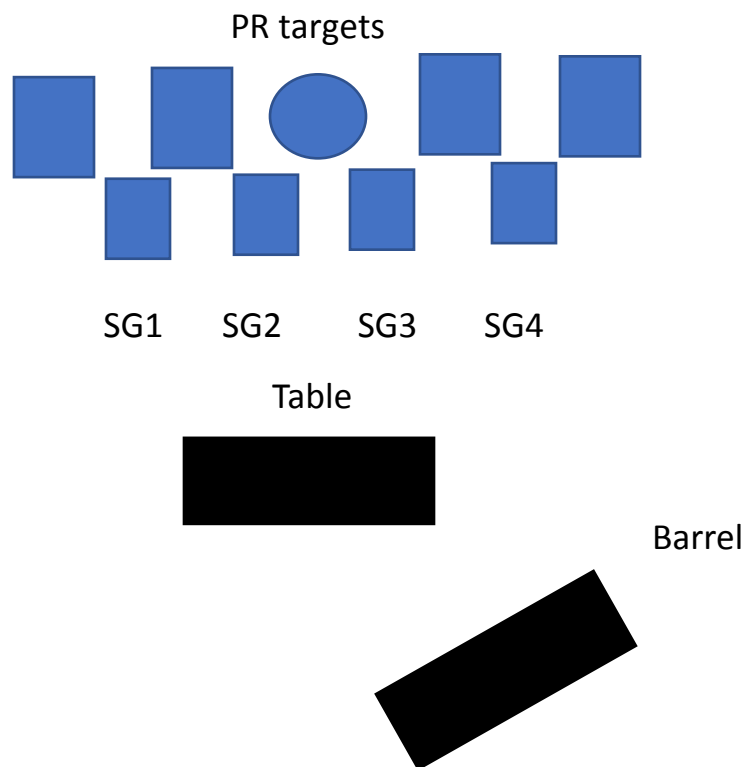
U.S. Marshal Crawley Dake offers Wyatt a position as U.S. Deputy Marshal. Wyatt turns him down and says, "That's final." Dake says, "OK. You are here to make some money. That's good but I never met a rich man that didn't have a guilty conscience." Wyatt replies, "I already got a guilty conscience. I might as well have the money."

Round Count: 10R- 10P- 4+SG

Shooting Order: R-SG-PP

Staging 2 P-5 each holstered R-10 rounds in Both hands SG on the barrel.

Shooter starts at the barrel rifle in both hands. Indicate ready by saying the line, "I might as well have the money". ATB engage the cowboy then Nevada Sweep the targets either direction. Make rifle safe, take SG to down range table engage shotgun targets any order. Repeat rifle instructions with pistols.



Stage 4 Jail

Saloon Blazing Saddles

After two of the workers drive a handcar into the quick sand, Mr. Taggart ropes it and pulls it out. Then he says, "Dang. That was lucky. Doggone near lost a four-hundred-dollar handcar."

Round Count: 10R- 10P- 4+SG

Shooting Order: R-PP-SG

Staging 2P-5 each holstered R-10 rounds on the target box SG staged anywhere safely.

Shooter starts with hands flat on the target box. Indicate ready by saying the line, "Dang, that was lucky." ATB engage rifle targets with a double tap Nevada Sweep from either direction. Repeat rifle instructions with pistols. At the right window engage SG targets any order.



Stage 5 Boot Hill

Alias Smith and Jones

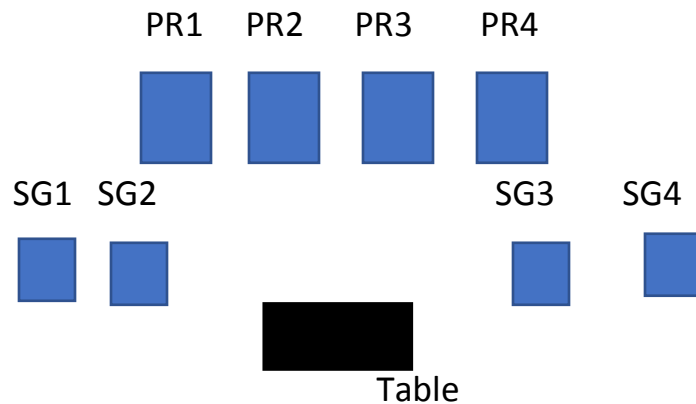
A well-armed posse is shooting at Hannibal Hays and Kid Curry. Curry tells Hays, "There's something we got to get." Hays asks, "What's that Kid?" Curry replies, "Out of this business!"

Round Count 10P-10R-4+SG

Shooting Order PP-R-SG

Staging 2P-5 each holstered R10 rounds on the barrel SG on the barrel.

Shooter starts at the barrel hands on hat brim. Indicate ready by saying the line, "Out of this business!" ATB Shooters choice 10 on 4 any order. Make rifle safe, with SG engage targets any order make SG safe on the barrel or table. At the table repeat rifle instructions with pistols.



Stage 6 - Livery

Briscoe County Jr.

Brisco and Bowler are on the trail of a newly formed outlaw gang. These young men are the best dressed and groomed men anyone has ever seen. Briscoe and Bowler find them at the livery stable. After a brief gun fight the men escape. Briscoe ask Bowler is it just me, or is that the best looking gang you have ever seen? Bowler replies, you know Brisco this business is getting to dang glamorous.

Round Count: 10P-10R-4+SG

Shooting Order: SG-shooter's choice-SG

Staging: 2P-5each holstered; Rifle 10 rounds on center table; SG in both hands at left window.

Shooter starts at the left window SG in both hands. Indicate ready by saying the line, **"This business is getting to dang glamorous."** ATB, engage SG 1 and 2 any order; make SG safe on center table. Shooter's choice next, pistols or rifle, engage the round target 4 times, then each square target 3 times. Same for rifle and pistols EX 4-3-3 then repeat. Take SG to right window; engage SG 3 and 4 any order.
