

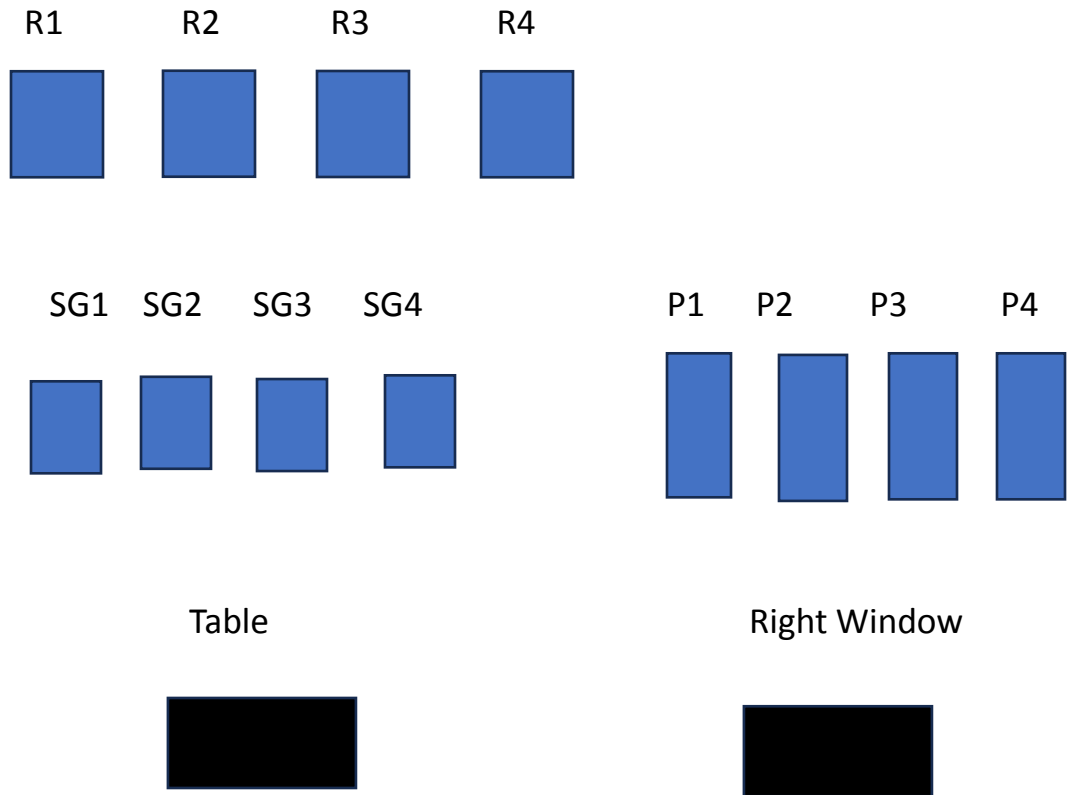
Stage 1 Saloon

Round Count: 10P-10R-4+SG Shooting Order: Shooters Choice Pistols Last

Staging 2P-5 each holstered R-10 rounds on table SG on the table.

Shooter starts hands flat on table. Indicate ready by saying the line, "I've been a cowboy all my life." Or cowgirl. ATB rifle 10 on 4 any order. SG any order. At the right window repeat rifle instructions with pistols.



Stage 2

Blazing Saddles

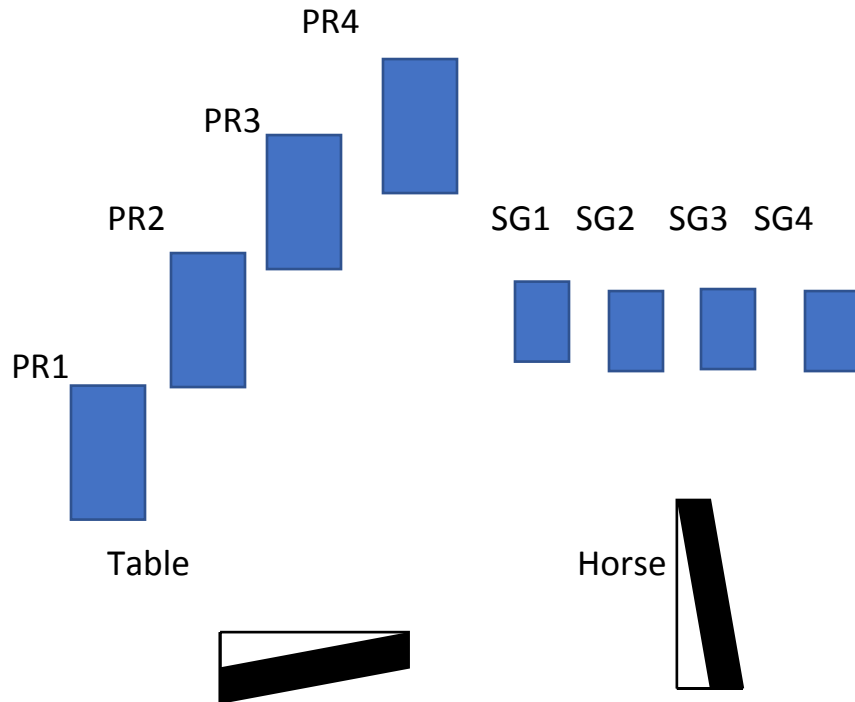
After two of the workers drive a handcar into the quick sand, Mr. Taggart ropes it and pulls it out. Then he says, "Dang. That was lucky. Doggone near lost a four-hundred-dollar handcar."

Round Count: 10P-10R-4+SG
last.

Shooting Order: Shooter's choice SG

Staging 2P-5 each holstered R-10 rounds on table SG on the horse.

Shooter starts at the table arms folder across chest. Indicate ready by saying the line, "Dang. That was lucky". ATB engage targets with pistols and rifle with a 2-4-6-8 sweep starting on either end target. At the horse engage SG targets any order.



Stage 3 Fort

McClintock

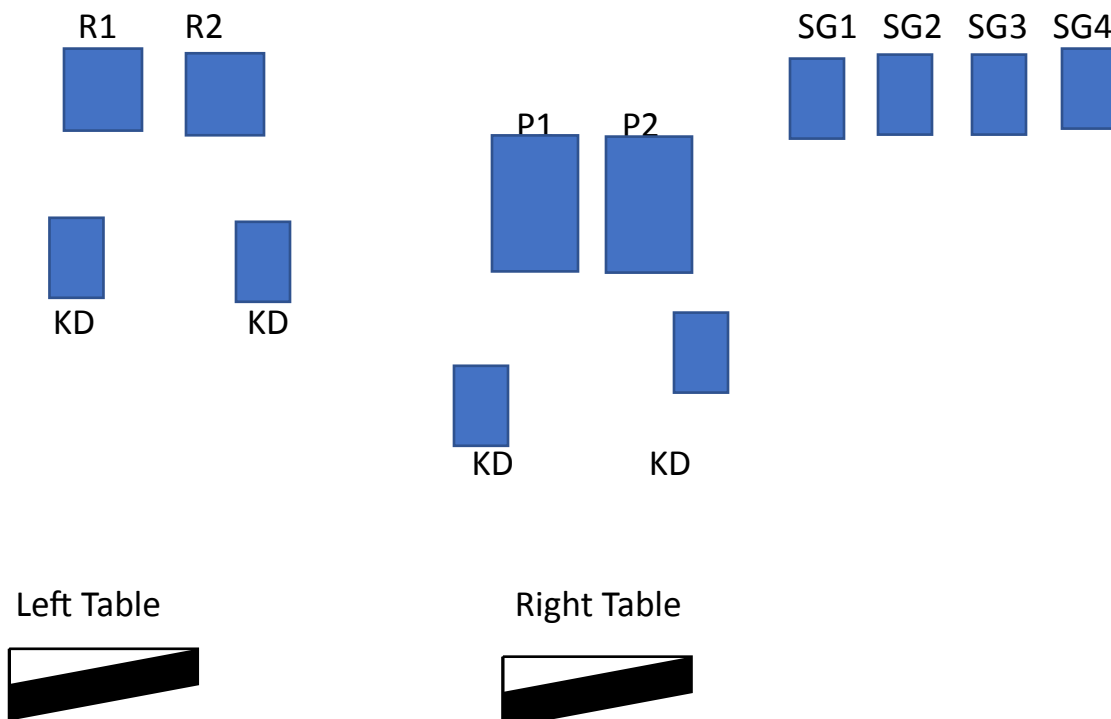
When Curley sees G.W.'s hat on the weather vane, he tells Drago, "This is the 7th time the Boss has come home drunk this month." Drago replies, "Six. Once was his birthday; that don't count."

Round Count: 10P-10R-4+SG

Shooting Order: R-PP-SG

Staging 2P-5-each holstered R-10 rounds in both hands SG on left table.

Shooter starts at the left table rifle in both hands. Indicate ready by saying the line "Once was his birthday; that don't count." ATB engage the 2 stationary targets with a double tap alternate from either direction for 8 rounds then engage the 2 KD targets. If KD targets are left standing make up with SG. Take SG to right table repeat rifle instructions with pistols. Engage 4 SG target anywhere between the right table and the side berm.



Stage 4 Jail

North West Mounted Police

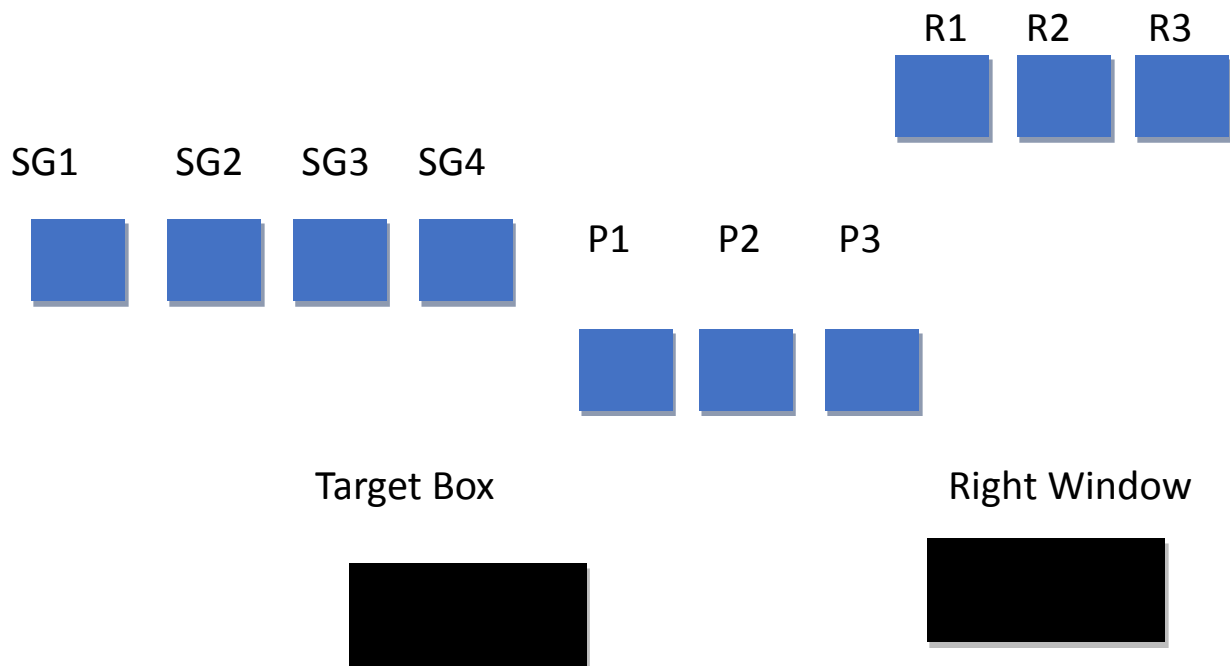
Texas Ranger Dusty Rivers has been sent to Canada to extradite the murderer, Jacques Corbeau. Upon his arrival at Mounted Police Head Quarters, the Mounties have never seen anything like Dusty. One of them asks, "Why do you carry two pistols?" Dusty replies, "One shoots farther than the other."

Round Count: 10R-10P-4+SG

Shooting Order: R-PP-SG

Staging: 2 Pistols 5 Rounds each holstered; Rifle 10 rounds in right window; SG open empty on target box.

Shooter starts at right window hands flat on window shelf. Indicate ready by saying the line, "One shoots farther than the other". ATB engage R2 two times then sweep the targets from either direction for a total of 5 rounds, then repeat. The sweep can be from either direction. Place open empty rifle on shelf or rack. Move to opening; repeat rifle instructions with pistols. Then shoot SG targets any order.



Stage 5 Boot Hill

Briscoe County Jr.

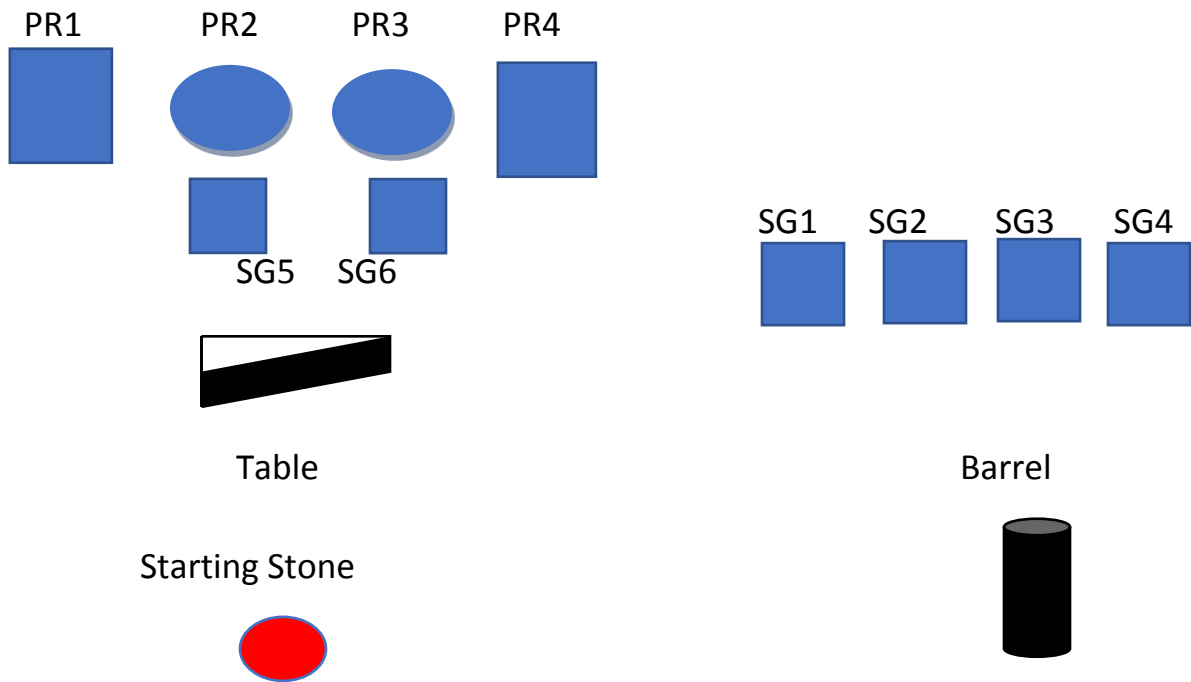
Briscoe see's Pete Hutter and asks, "Correct me if I'm wrong, Pete. Weren't you killed in a gunfight?" Pete replies, "I was only gut shot. I healed, I'm stronger now just with less appetite."

Round Count 10P-10R-6+SG

Shooting Order R-SG-PP

Staging 2P-5 each holstered R-10 rounds in both hands SG on the barrel.

Shooter starts one foot touching starting stone Rifle in both hands. Indicate ready by saying the line, "I was only gut shot". ATB triple tap an inside round target then single tap all 4 targets then triple the other round inside target. Ex: 3-1-1-1-1-3. Make the rifle safe on the barrel engage SG 1-2-3-4 any order anywhere between the barrel and table. At the down range table engage SG 5-6 any order. Repeat rifle instructions with pistols.



Stage 6 Livery

Butch Cassidy and The Sundance Kid

After getting off the train in the poorest looking city they have ever seen, an extremely upset Sundance tells Butch, "I can't believe I let you talk me into this!" Butch replies, "All of Bolivia can't look like this." Sundance yells back, "For all you know this could be the garden spot of the entire country; people could travel for hundreds of miles just to see this!" Butch tells Etta, "He'll feel better after he's robbed a couple of banks.

Round Count: 10P-10R-4+SG

Shooting Order: PP-R-SG

Staging: 2P 5 rounds each holstered; Rifle 10 rounds on center table; SG open empty on center table.

Shooter starts at left window hands on window frame. Indicate ready by saying the line, "All of Bolivia can't look like this." At the beep, with pistols, shoot a continuous double tap clockwise rotation starting on any target. At the table; repeat pistol instructions on rifle targets. Place open empty rifle on table; with SG shoot SG 1 and 2 from the table. Move to right window and shoot SG3 and 4.
