

Stage 1 Saloon

Red River

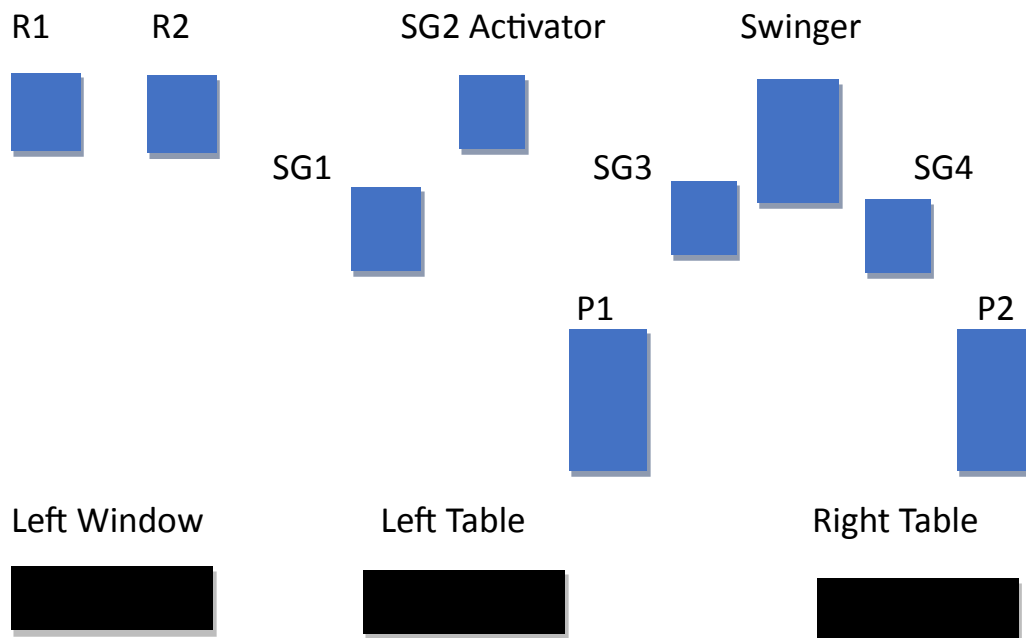
Line: "Hand me that iron, Teeler!"

Round Count:10P-10R-4+SG

Shooting Order: R-SG-PP

Staging; 2P-5 each holstered R-10 rounds in left window SG on left table.

Shooter starts at the left window hands on pistols. Indicate ready by saying the line, "Hand me that iron, Teeler!" ATB with rifle alternate 10 rounds on the rifle target's either direction. At the left table engage SG 1 and 2. SG 2 is the swinger activator. Move to right table engage SG 3 and 4 on the swinger. With pistols starting on the swinger alternate 5 rounds between the swinger an either stationary target. Then repeat on the swinger and the other stationary target.



Stage 2 Well

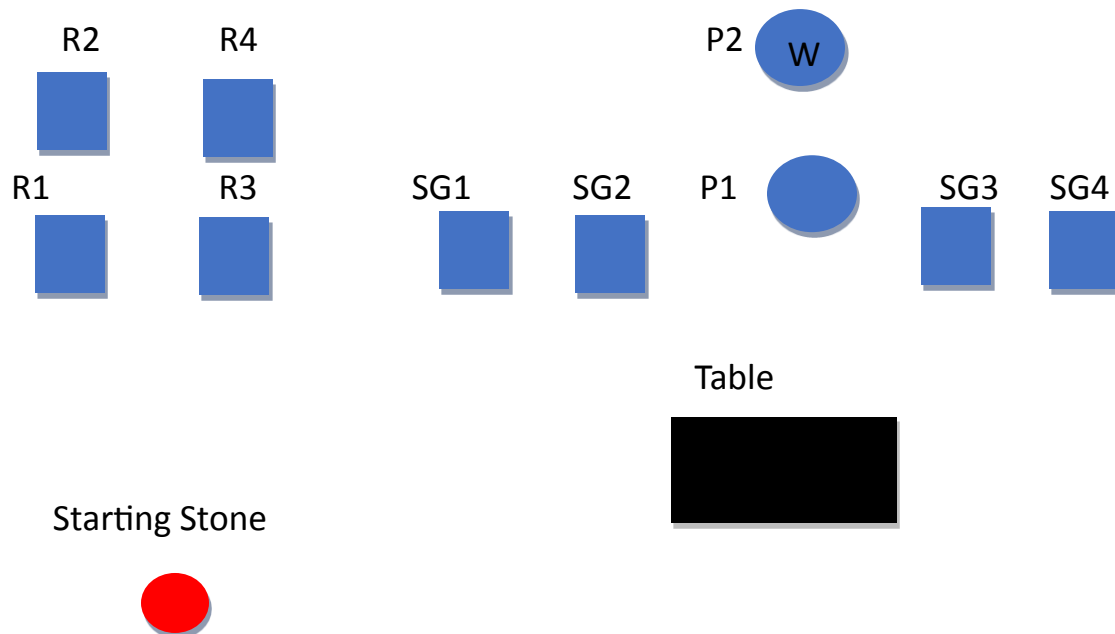
Lonesome Dove

Clara asks Gus, why is Lorie on this cattle drive with you?" Gus tells her, "It's an accident she is even on this trip." Clara replies, "I never noticed you having accidents with ugly girls."

Round Count: 10P-10R-4+SG Shooting order: Rifle, Then shooter's choice.

Staging; 2P-5 each holstered R-10 Rounds in both hands SG on the table.

Shooter starts one foot touching starting stone rifle in both hands. Indicate ready by saying the line, "It's an accident she is even on this trip." ATB starting on either bottom target engage targets 2-3 then repeat starting on the other bottom target. EX: bottom target 2 times top target 3 times. Make rifle safe on the table. Engage SG targets any order. With pistols engage targets 2-3 starting on the bottom target then repeat with second pistol.



Stage 3 Fort

Rio Bravo

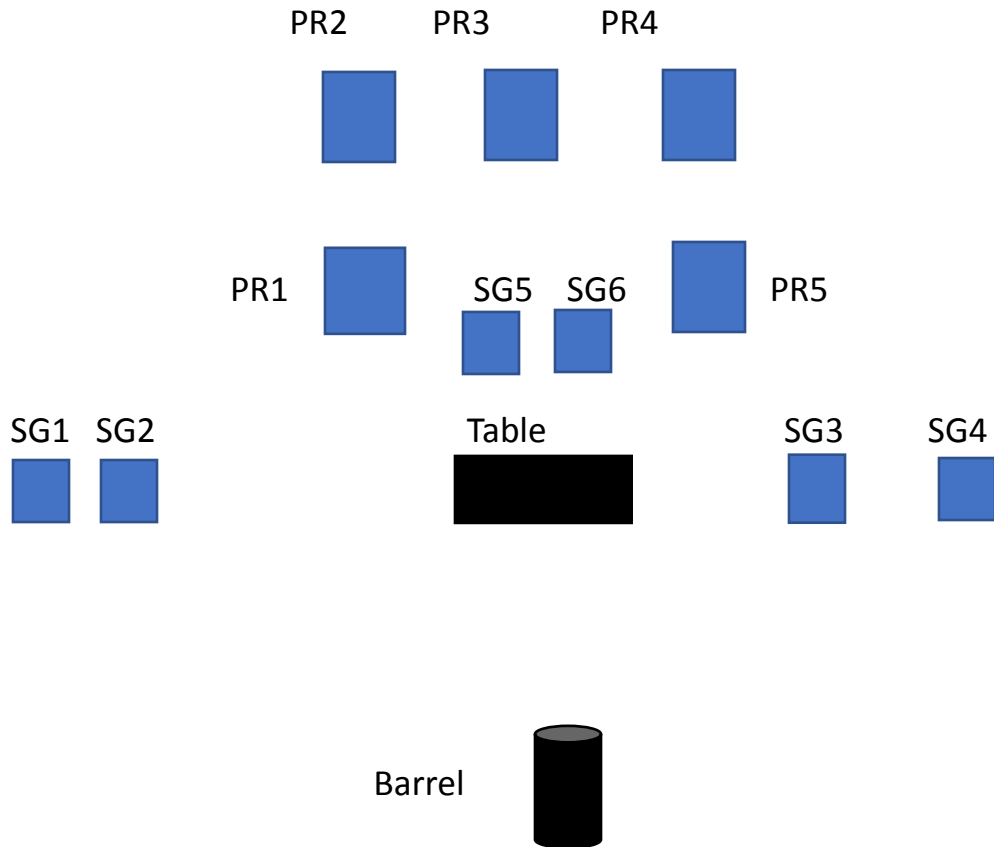
Joe is bragging to John T. this jail won't hold me my brother and his men will get me out. John T: you're not as smart as your brother; he sees Stumpy in here with his shotgun. And knows if his men storm the jail you're going to get shot, accidentally of course. Stumpy tells Joe, "I can practical guarantee that".

Round Count: 10P-10R-6+SG

Shooting Order: R-SG-PP

Staging 2P-5 each holstered R10-rounds in both hands SG on the barrel.

Shooter starts at the barrel rifle in both hands. Indicate ready by saying the line, "I can practical grantee that". ATB engage rifle targets 2 times each any order. Make rifle safe engage SG targets 1-2-3-4 between barrel and table at the table engage SG 5-6. Make SG safe on the table repeat rifle instructions with pistols.



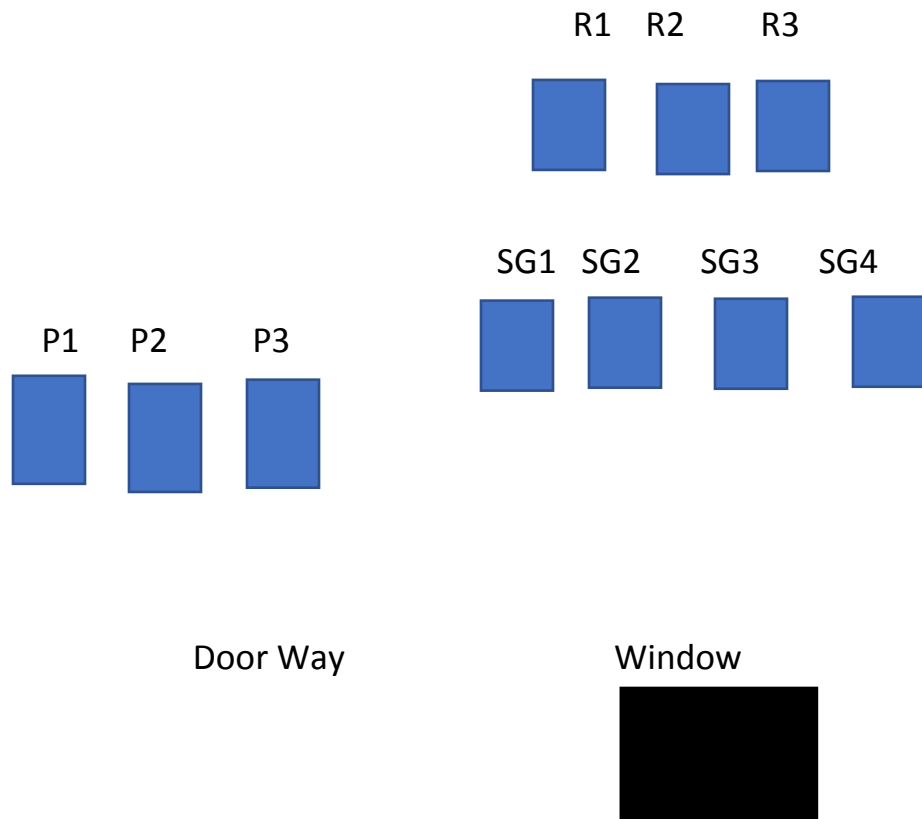
Stage 4 Jail

Conagher

After Conagher tracks down the stolen horses, the thief Coker asks, "You just going to leave me here afoot? It's 50 miles back to the Ladder 5." Conagher replies, "Tuff life being an outlaw."

Round Count: 10P-10R-4+SG Shooting Order: Shooter's choice pistols last.

Staging 2P-5 each holstered R10-rounds in window or rack SG in window or rack. Shooter starts at the window hands on window frame. Indicate ready by saying the line, "Tuff life being an outlaw." ATB engage rifle targets with two Vigilantly sweeps either direction either time. EX: 1-2-1-2-3 Then repeat. Engage SG targets any order. At the doorway repeat rifle instructions with pistols.



Stage 5 Boot Hill

Wyatt Earp

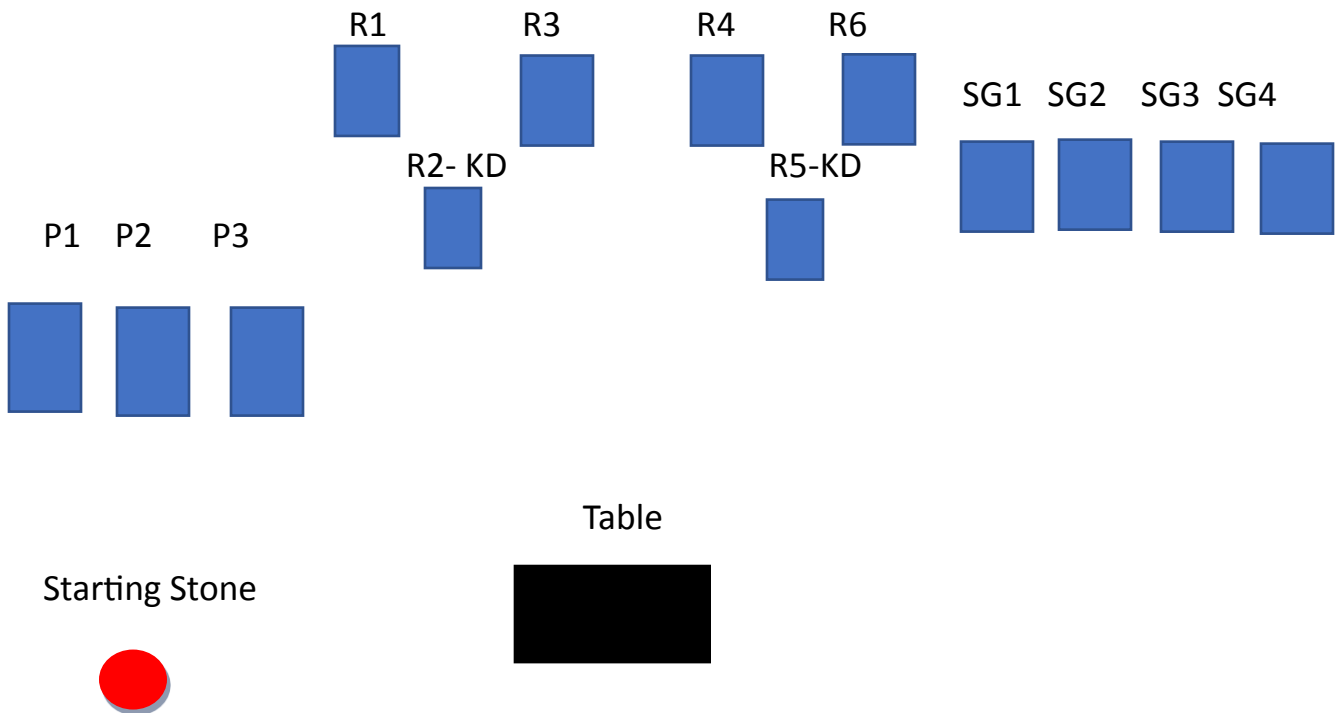
Doc's opinion of Dave Rudabaugh: "Dave Rudabaugh is an ignorant scoundrel! I disapprove of his very existence. I considered ending it myself on several occasions but self-control got the better of me."

Round Count: 10P-10 R-4+SG

Shooting Order: PP-R-SG

Staging 2P-5 each holstered 10R- rounds on table SG on table.

Shooter starts one foot touching starting stone hands on pistols. Indicate ready by saying the line, "Self-control got the better of me." ATB sweep pistol targets 2-1-2 from either direction either time. At the table sweep rifle targets 2-1-2-2-1-2 from either direction. EX: 2-KD-2-2-KD-2. KD targets still standing can be made up with SG. Engage SG targets any order anywhere the table and side berm.



Stage 6 Livery

Wyatt Earp

John Shawnessy Introduces Wyatt to Doc. Doc says, "Wyatt Earp. I've heard that name before. Don't know where, but it wasn't good."

Round Count: 10R-10P-4+SG

Shooting Order: PP-R-SG

Staging 2P-5 each holstered R-10 rounds on the table SG staged safely. Note, SG can be staged on table but must be shot through right window.

Shooter starts at the table hands on hat brim Indicate ready by saying the line, "It wasn't good." ATB engage P2- 3 times then P1 and P3 one time each. Then repeat. EX:3-1-1 then repeat. Repeat pistol instructions with rifle. Engage SG targets any order.
